

Matthew 6:11-13

MEMORY VERSE

"But you, when you pray, go into your room, and when you have shut your door, pray to your Father who is in the secret place; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you openly." Matthew 6:6

TRUE OR FALSE:

1 ("Give us this week our weekly bread." Matthew 6:11

- "Give us this day..." not this month, not this year. Why does the Lord want us to pray day-by-day? Because prayer, in and of itself, is our greatest need and expresses ultimate dependence upon God. Ask God for everything you need and for everything your family needs.
- It is important to recognize that it all comes from God, our "Abba Father."
- Is there a good example to follow?
- **2** ("And forgive us our debts, as we do not forgive our debtors." *Matthew 6:12*



- Ask Him to show you if you are doing anything that does not please Him and then ask God to forgive you. Be willing to change. God is concerned that we don't get a hard heart, that He wants us to consider our own sins every day as we pray. Read 1 John 1:9.
- Pray: "Keep me from being self-righteous (confident in my own righteousness) and keep me from being self-justifying (offering a lot of excuses) and keep me from being self-deceived (fooling myself).
- Is there a good example to follow?
- Is there a bad example to shun (not follow)?
- Is there a new or fresh thought about God?
- Forgive anyone who has sinned against you or hurt your feelings.
- Is there a warning to heed?
- 3 ("And do not lead us into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one." *Matthew 6:13*



- You can also read it this way; "Keep me from temptation, and deliver me from the evil one..."
- Jesus is teaching us to acknowledge our weakness. Read Psalm 78:39 and 103:14.
- Ask God to help you stay away from sin and bad things.
- Pray: "Lord, keep me from the temptation of _______
- Is there a new or fresh thought about God the Father? He can help us overcome.
- Read: Psalm 119:133
- Is there a fresh insight into the person of Satan?
- 4 ("For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen." *Matthew 6:13*



- End with a time of praise. Commit to live for God and His kingdom for the rest of the day, and for the rest of your life.
- What is being said here at the end of the prayer is "Lord, it is Your kingdom, it is Your power, it is Your glory. Pray: "I just want to be a part of Your kingdom, Your power, and Your glory."
- Is there a new or fresh thought about God the Father?


