

- The word "manner" means 'pray like this then.'

- 2 "...Our Father..." Matthew 6:9



- Thank God that you are His child and that He is your perfect Father! It is always wise, before we pray, to spend time
 deliberately recalling who God is. The word for 'Father' is 'Abba', meaning 'Papa'. (Romans 8:15) This speaks of how
 much God cares for us. He is the One who cares for us. (1 Peter 5:7)
- Jesus is teaching us that there is a loving Father (our Father) who is eagerly waiting to meet with us.
- 3 ("...in heaven..." *Matthew 6:9*



- "in heaven" focuses on how far above man God dwells. It takes the focus off of my problems, and puts my focus on He who is able to do anything! Also, it focuses my attention on some of God's attributes; His greatness, He is everywhere, He is eternal, He knows everything, He is all powerful there is nothing too hard for God to do.
- What does "attribute" mean?
- Is there a new or fresh thought about God the Father?
- 4 (*...Hallowed be Your name..." Matthew 6:9



- Read Psalm 8:1. By the "name" of God is meant all those attributes through which He is revealed to us His power, goodness, wisdom, holiness, mercy, and truth. By stating God's name that it be "hallowed," we mean that, "May His name be made known and glorified."
- Pray: "May Your name be glorified and magnified in and through my life."
- Is there a new or fresh thought about God the Father?


