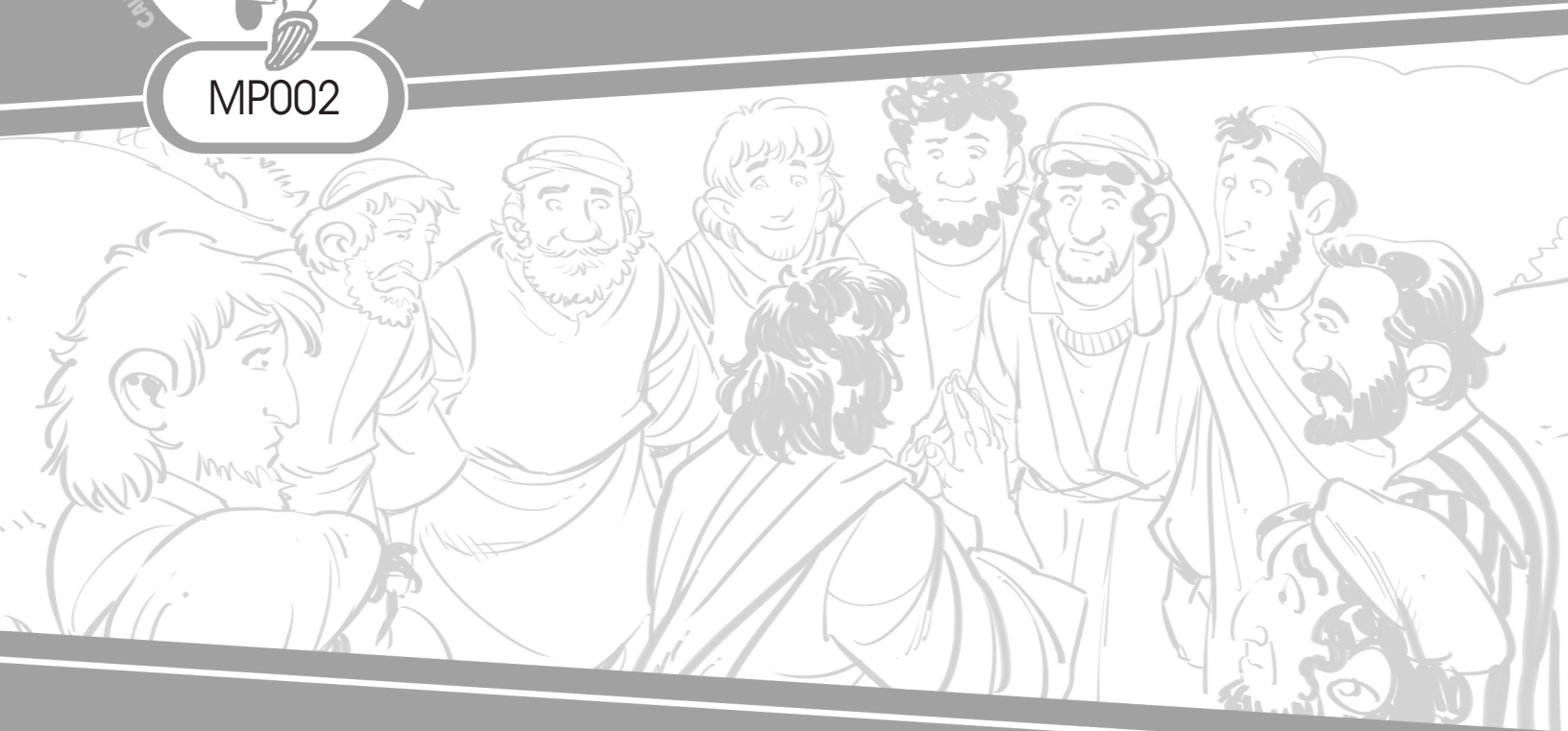

- The word "manner" means 'pray like this then.'
- Is there a command to obey?

2 "...Our Father..." Matthew 6:9

- Thank God that you are His child and that He is your perfect Father! It is always wise, before we pray, to spend time deliberately recalling who God is. The word for 'Father' is 'Abba', meaning 'Papa'. (Romans 8:15) This speaks of how much God cares for us. He is the One who cares for us. (1 Peter 5:7)
- Jesus is teaching us that there is a loving Father (our Father) who is eagerly waiting to meet with us.

3 "...in heaven..." Matthew 6:9

- "in heaven" focuses on how far above man God dwells. It takes the focus off of my problems, and puts my focus on He who is able to do anything! Also, it focuses my attention on some of God's attributes; His greatness, He is everywhere, He is eternal, He knows everything, He is all powerful – there is nothing too hard for God to do.
- What does "attribute" mean?
- Is there a new or fresh thought about God the Father?

4 "...Hallowed be Your name..." Matthew 6:9

- Read Psalm 8:1. By the "name" of God is meant all those attributes through which He is revealed to us – His power, goodness, wisdom, holiness, mercy, and truth. By stating God's name that it be "hallowed," we mean that, "May His name be made known and glorified."
- Pray: "May Your name be glorified and magnified in and through my life."
- Is there a new or fresh thought about God the Father?

- "Seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness..." Matthew 6:33
- Pray: "Lord, let me seek no other kingdom but Yours." God's kingdom means what God rules over.

- Is there a good example to follow?

- This part of the prayer is a good time for intercessory prayer. What is intercessory prayer?
- We also can pray for the return of the Lord.

6 "...Your will be _____ on earth as it is in heaven." Matthew 6:10

- Is there a good example to follow?
- For God's perfect will to be done in your life – for yourself and others.
- Pray: "May God's will, and not my will, be done in and through my life."
- This is a good time to pray for those who are actively doing the work of the Lord, such as: missionaries, pastors, children's ministry teachers, etc.

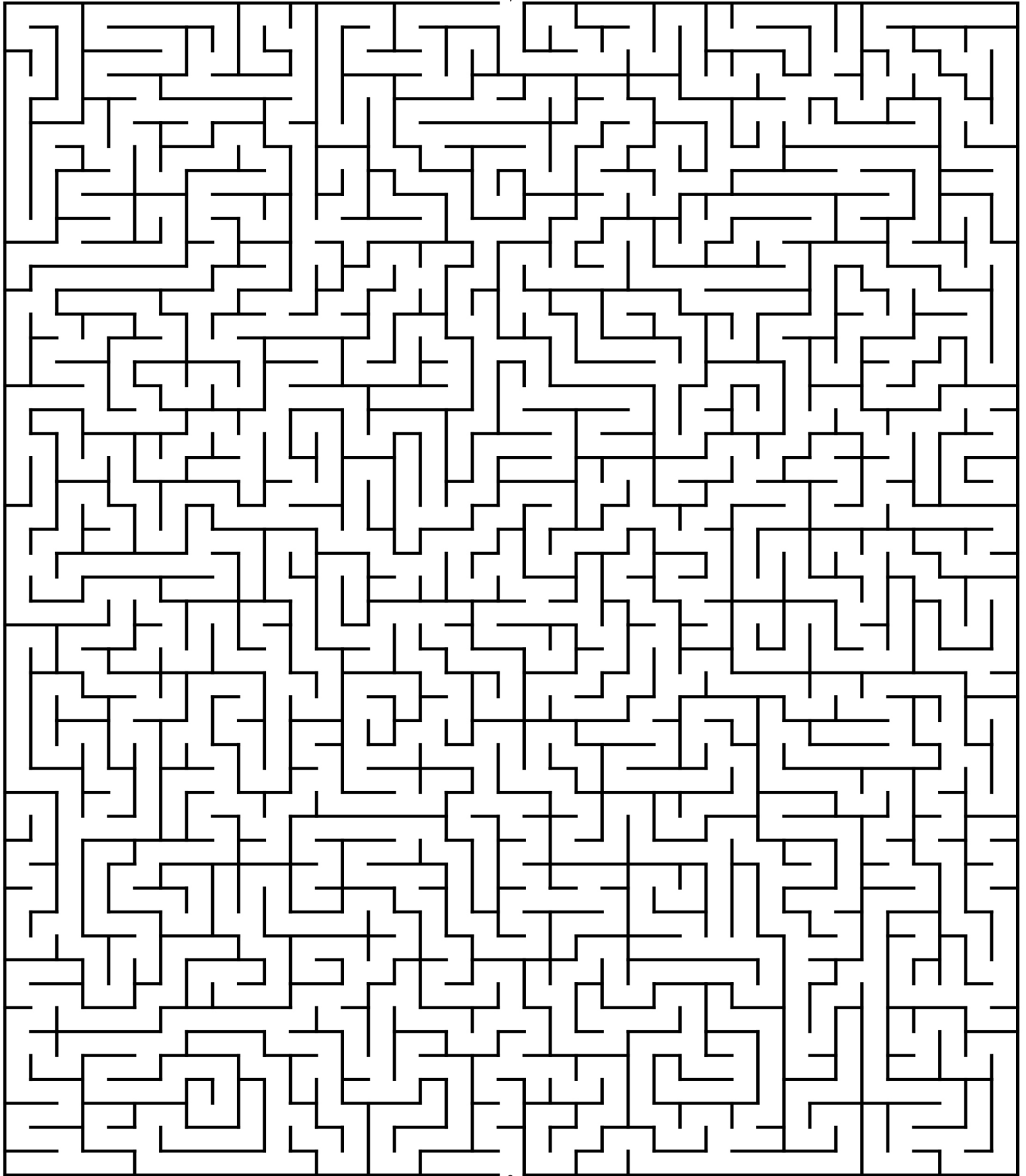
