

GENESIS 6:5 - 7:5



UNDERSTANDING THE STORY

When God first created the world and people, everything was perfect and good in every way.

• Do you know what made things change? Why is there badness/sin in the world? (Genesis 3)

The people on the earth became so wicked/sinful that God had to punish them.

- Imagine people only thinking bad things ALL of the time that's what was happening. How did God feel in His heart? (Genesis 6:6)
- What did God say he would do because of people's wickedness?

There was one man who was different from everyone else.

- What was this man's name? What made Noah different?
- What did Noah do? (Genesis 6:9) What does it mean to "walk with God?"

God told Noah that He would destroy all that was on the earth with a flood.

- What is a flood? Why would God send a flood onto the whole earth?
- What did God tell Noah to make? Why did God want Noah to make an ark?
- What would happen to everything on the dry land, that was outside the ark?

God told Noah to come into the ark with his family.

- How many of each kind of animal went inside the ark with Noah and his family?
- How many days and nights did God say it would rain?
- Did Noah do all that God told him to do?

SIMPLE TRUTHS:

It's sad to think that people were so wicked/sinful that God had to punish them.

- Would it be good for people to keep on doing bad things without being punished?
- How do you think it makes God feel when people today want to sin and don't want to love God?

Think about Noah. He was different, because he loved God.

- Do you want to be like Noah and love God? Do you want to be like Noah and obey God?
- If people around you are doing bad things, do you have to do bad things too? Can you love God even if the people around you don't love God? Will God help you to do what is right? (He helped Noah!)
- Noah walked with God. How can we walk with God? (By talking to Him praying, by listening to Him from the Bible, and by obeying Him doing whatever He says!)

Noah did all that God told him to do.

- What kind of person do you want to be someone who does bad, sinful things, or someone who loves and obeys God?
- Do you want to ask God to help you love and obey Him more?
- It's important to ask Jesus to forgive us of our sins and make us a part of God's family. If you have never done that, do you want to right now? God loves you so much and wants to save you from sin.


