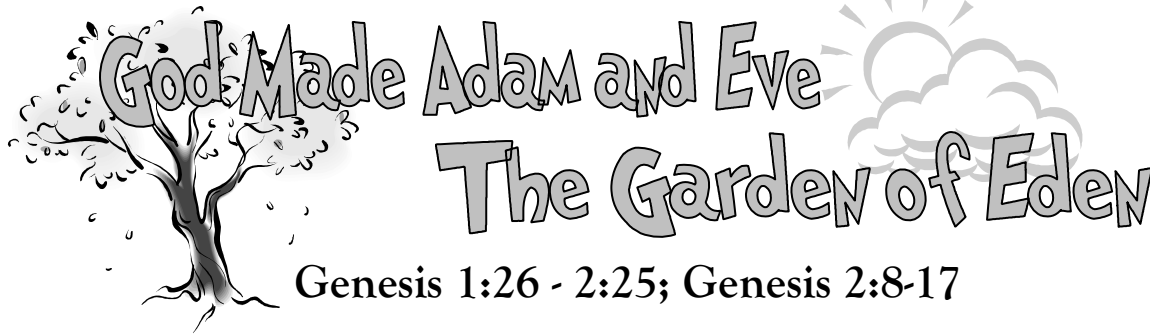


God Made Adam and Eve

GENESIS 1:26 - 2:25; GENESIS 2:8-17

Today in class I learned what the Bible says about...



- On the sixth day, after God had created everything else, He made man from the dust of the earth.
- Adam was made in the image of God, because God wanted Adam to love Him, as God loved Adam.
- Adam walked and talked with God. God told him to name all the animals.
- God saw that Adam was alone, so He put Adam to sleep and made a woman from the rib of his side. Adam named her Eve.
- After God had finished, He declared everything was very good.
- God commanded that the seventh day should be a day of rest.
- Sunday is a special day, set apart to worship God with His people. It is a day to sing His praises together in church, to talk to Him in prayer, and to listen as God talks to us from His Word, the Bible.

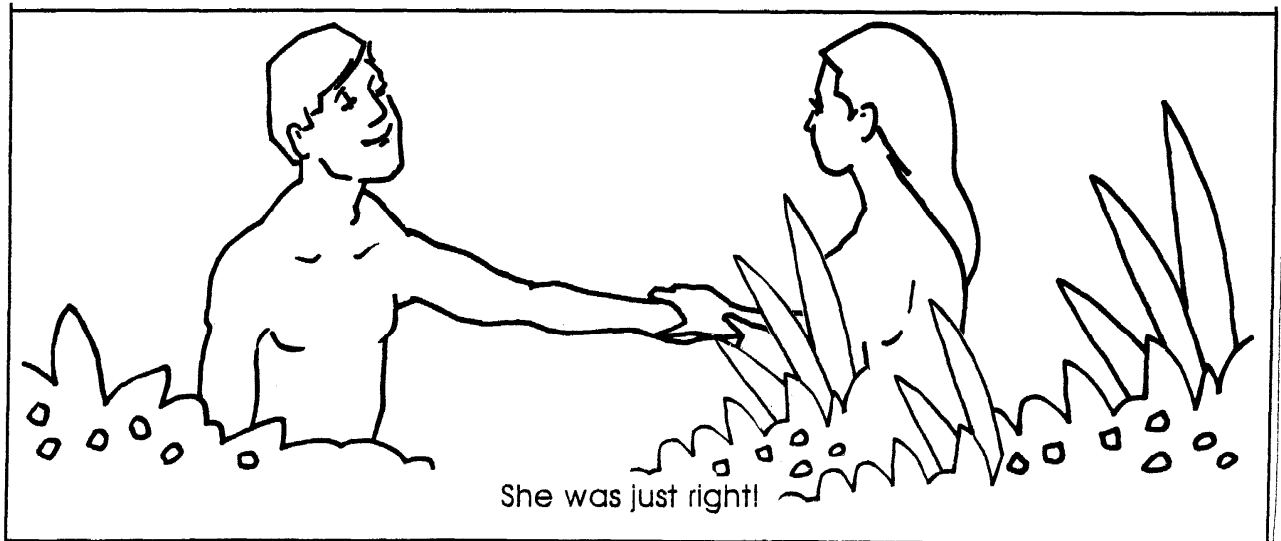
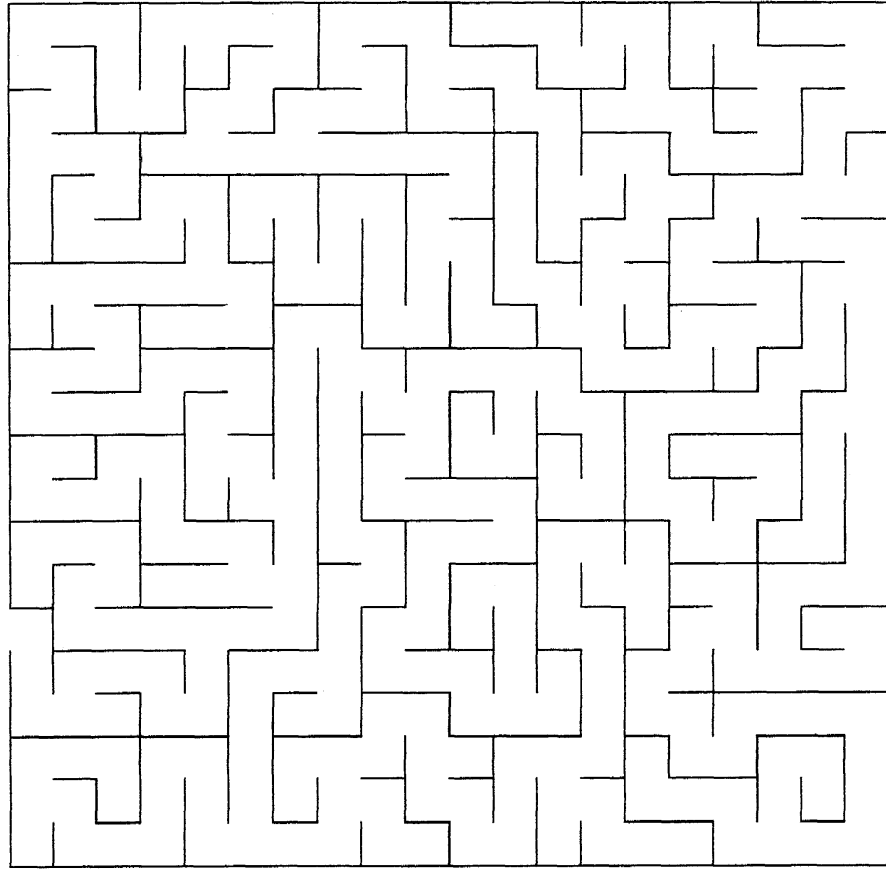
