## I Samuel 1:1-19; 2:20-21

- Elkanah had two wives, Hannah and Peninnah. Peninnah had children and made fun of Hannah because she had none.
- When Hannah was at the temple of the Lord, she prayed to God that if He would give her a child, then she would give him back to God for the rest of his life. The priest, Eli, first thought Hannah was drunk. When he realized she was not, Eli asked that the Lord would grant her request.
- Hannah later had a son and named him Samuel. When he was about 4 years old, Hannah brought him to the temple to serve the Lord for his entire life. Whenever Hannah visited Samuel, she would bring a little coat that she had made for him. God later gave Hannah more sons and daughters.
