# Healing The Nobleman's Son

John 4:46-54



- A nobleman had a son who was dying. He came to Jesus in Cana and asked Jesus to heal his son.
- Jesus said to the nobleman, "Go your way; your son lives."
- The man believed Jesus' words and returned home. He found that his son was well, and asked when he had been healed. The son had been healed at the exact time that Jesus had said he was healed.
- He and his entire household believed in Jesus.

- Is any prayer too difficult for Jesus to answer?
- What would you like Jesus to help you with?

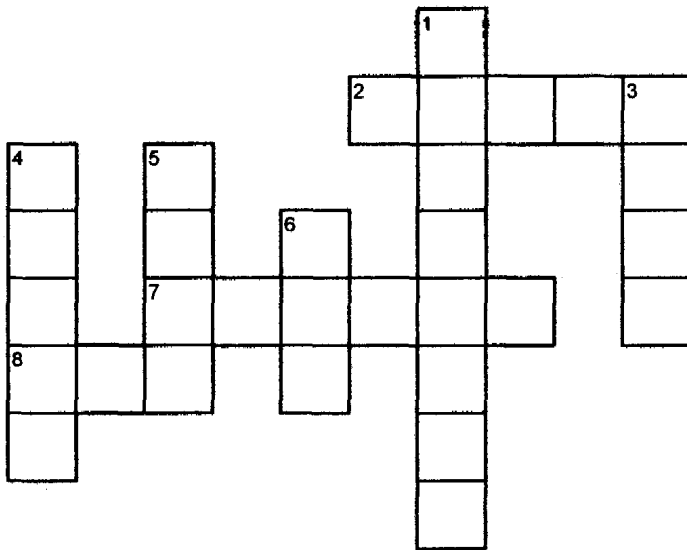
