John 3:1-21

- Nicodemus was a Pharisee. Most of the Pharisees did not believe that Jesus was sent by God, but Nicodemus did.
- Nicodemus came to Jesus by night to talk to him about the kingdom of God. Jesus told him that being a good person could not get anyone into God's kingdom, but that he needed to be born again by the Spirit of God in order to enter the kingdom of heaven.
- Jesus then told him that the way to be born again by the Spirit was to believe in God's Son that was sent to die for the whole world.
