## Matthew 27-28; Mark 15-16; Luke 23-24; John 19-20

- While Jesus was nailed on the cross, He prayed for those who made fun of Him.
- Even in His great suffering, Jesus did not think of Himself, but of others. The first words He uttered were a prayer; "Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do."
- When Jesus died, the sky went dark, the earth quaked, and the veil in the temple was torn in two from the top to the bottom.
- The captain of the Roman soldiers declared, "Truly, this was the Son of God!"
- After Jesus died, He was buried in a tomb. The disciples, His friends, and His family were filled with sorrow. Three days later, He arose from the dead as He said that He would, and appeared alive to many people.
