## John the Baptist & John Baptizes Jesus

Matthew 3; Mark 1:1-15; Luke 3:1-22; John 1:1-36.

- God sent John the Baptist to the Jordan river where he preached to the people and baptized those that repented of their sin.
- John told messengers from the religious leaders that he was not their Savior, but was sent to prepare the way for the Savior.
- Later, Jesus came to be baptized by John. When Jesus came out of the water, God declared from heaven that Jesus was His Son and that He was pleased with Him. The Spirit, in the form of a dove, then came down and remained with Him.
- John then declared to the people that Jesus was their Savior that was sent to take away the sins of the world.

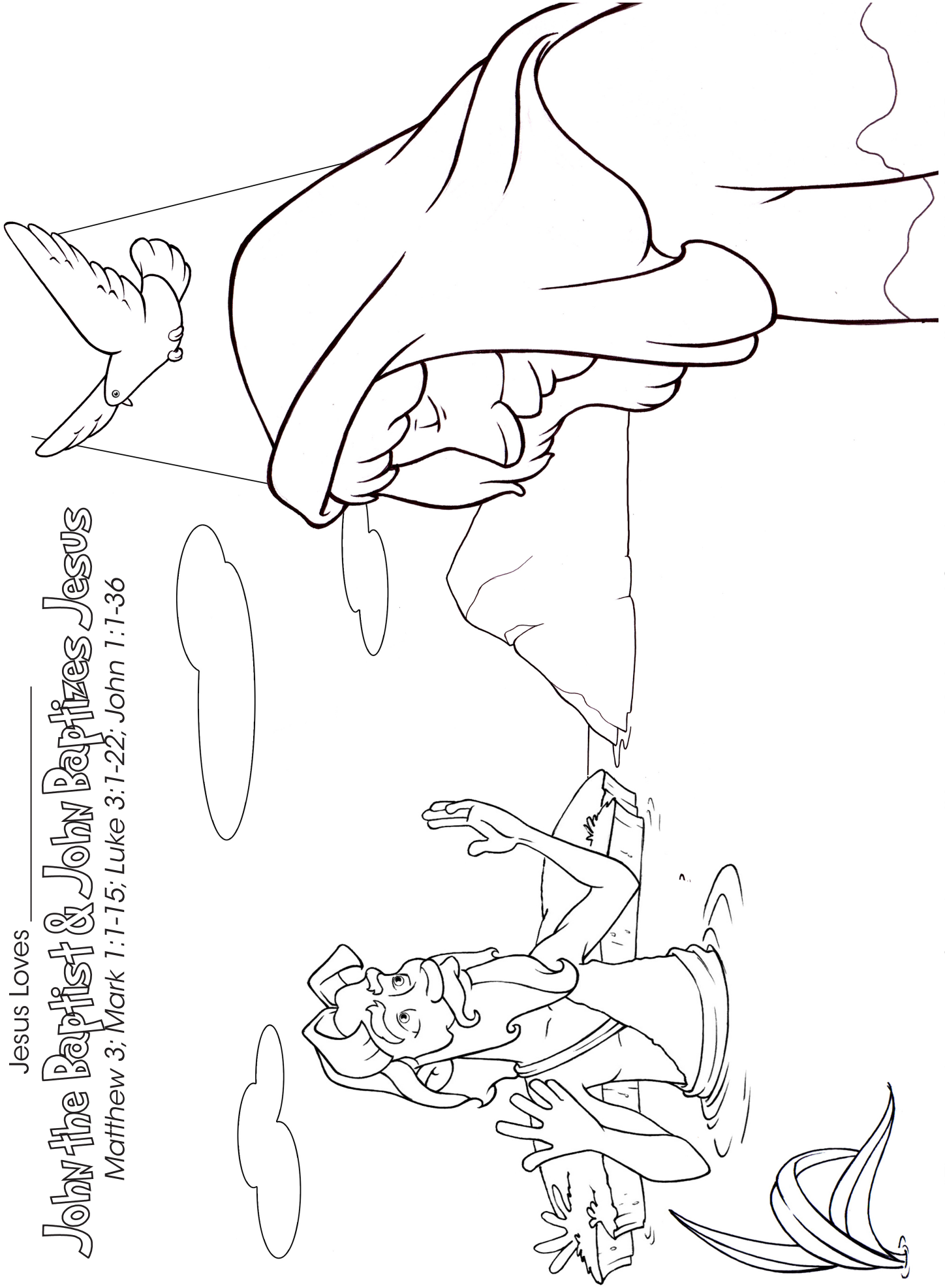
