## Jovala \& the Great fith <br> Jonah 1:1-2:10

- God told Jonah to go the city of Nineveh and tell them to repent, or God would destroy them. Because Jonah didn't want to obey, he got on a ship heading to Tarshish.
- While on the boat, a terrible storm came up and the crew feared for their lives. They determined that Jonah was the reason that God has brought the storm. Jonah told them to throw him overboard and then the storm would stop.
- After the sailors threw Jonah overboard, a giant fish swallowed Jonah. After living in the fish for three days, Jonah repented and the fish vomited him up on the land.
