Moses Is Born

Exodus 2:1-10

- During the time that the Israelites were slaves in Egypt, Pharaoh decreed that all baby boys would be killed. An Israelite woman had a son and hid him for three months.
- After three months, when she could not hide him any more, she made an ark and placed the baby in the Nile river among the bulrushes.
- When the Pharaoh's daughter was bathing, she found him and determined to adopt him, and named him Moses. The baby's mother was brought to nurse Moses for the Pharaoh's daughter.

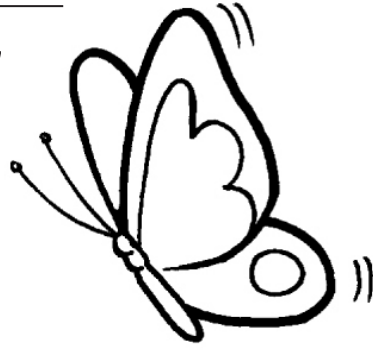

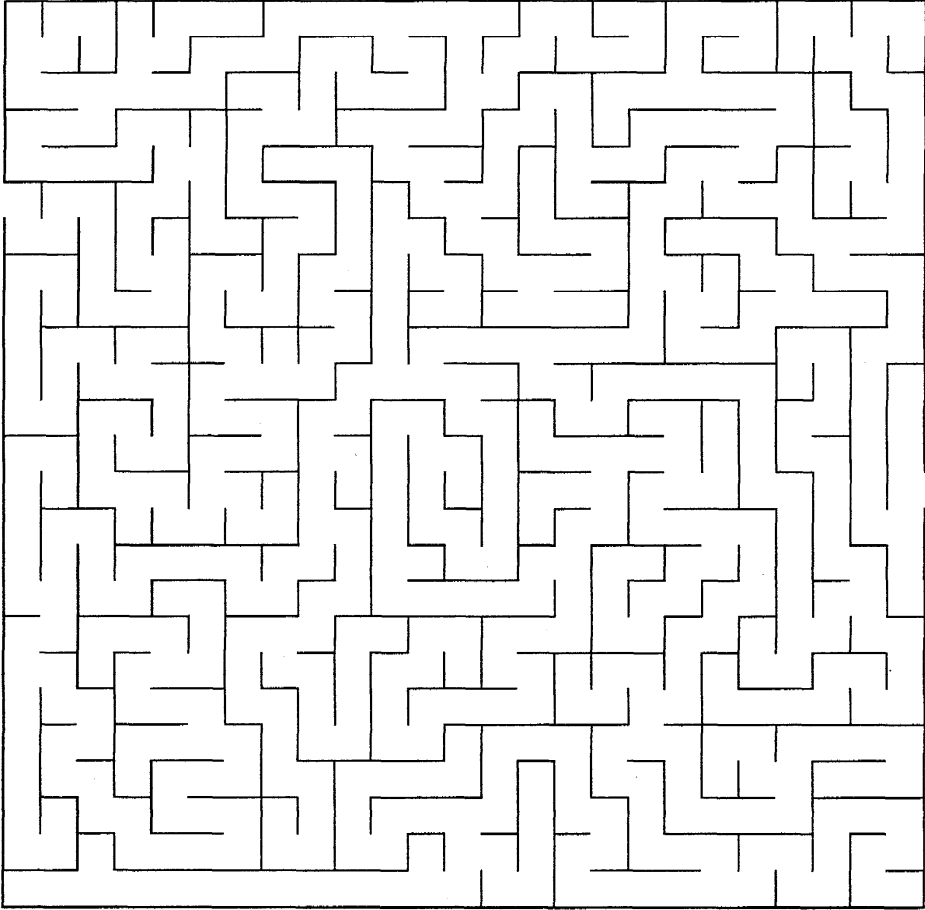
