## I Samuel 3:1-20

- During the time that Samuel served God, Eli was the high priest. His sons were very wicked and Eli did nothing to restrain them.
- As Samuel slept, he heard a voice call to him. He thought it was Eli and ran to him, but Eli said he did not call him. After two more times, Eli told Samuel that the next time he heard the voice to say, "Speak Lord, for your servant is listening."
- When the Lord called again to Samuel, He told him that He was going to punish Eli's wicked sons by killing them both in one day.
- In the morning, Eli asked Samuel to tell him what the Lord had said. Samuel told him and Eli said, "It is the Lord. Let Him do what seems good to Him."
