The Daughter of Jairus

Luke 8:40-42, 49-56; Mark 5:21-24, 35-43

- A rich man, named Jairus, had a daughter who was dying. He came to Jesus and asked Him to heal her. As Jesus and Jairus walked back to his house, the little girl died. Jesus told Jairus not to be afraid, but simply believe and she would be healed.
- When they got to the house, Jesus sent out the mourners because they laughed at him when he said that the girl was only sleeping.
- He took the girl's hand and said, "Little girl, get up!" The girl came back to life and Jesus told her parents to give her food.
