## Daniel 3:1-30

- Nebuchadnessar, king of Babylon, set up a golden image and demanded that all the people fall down and worship it. All the people worshiped, but Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-nego refused to.
- They only worshiped the God of Israel, and they refused to worship the image. The king threw them into a fiery furnace, and when he looked, he saw three and one more that looked like the Son of God.
- When the king called them out, they were not burned at all. The king then declared that whoever spoke against the God of these men would be killed.

## What does the Bible say:

- What did King Nebuchadnezzar want everyone to do? (bow down)
- Did everyone bow down and worship the golden image?
- Why did the king throw Daniel's three friends into the furnace?
- How did God help them?
- How did the king praise God?
- Who was the fourth figure in the fire that King Nebuchadnezzar recognized?


## What does it mean:

- Does God's Word tell us to worship Him only?
- Will God take care of you if you worship Him?
- Have you ever been asked to not worship God? What did you do?
- Has anyone made fun of you because you love God?


## What does it mean to me:

- Will you please God today, even if you think it will upset people?
- Is God speaking something to your heart to do that would please Him?
- What do you think would have happened if the three men had worshiped the king's statue?
