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



Many, many people in the world don't know why they are alive or the **PURPOSE** for their lives. Bor YOU can know! In these stUDIES we will discuss things you may have wondered about,



or things you may not have thought about yet.

We will LOGK at what the BIBLE, CODE WORD, has to say about the **PURPOSE** for which we were **GREATED**. We can know FOR SURE that COD has a reason that we are alive and that He has a wonderful plan for our lives. So, let's get started **FRICHENT**

We are going to talk a lot about **FAITTH**; what it is and why it's important to have **FAITTH**. But, before we start talking about **FAITTH**, we want to talk about having the RIGHT **STANDARD** for life.





WHY WAS CREATED?



A STANDARD is used to measure something. If you were asked how long a certain table is, you might say it is 6 feet long or 2 yards long. In the first measurement, you used a ruler as the STANDARD. In the second measurement, you used a tape measure as the STANDARD.


We also use **STANDARD**S to measure our lives, and the good or bad things we do in our lives.



If you use bad people as the **\$TANDARD** for your life, then you might say, *"Hey, I'm not as bad as those people! They are much worse than I am!"*

But, we are not to use people as our **STANDARD**. There is only one **STANDARD** that we are to use and that is $\mathcal{COD'S}$ **STANDARD**! We want other people to live by a right **STANDARD** but we do not always live under that **STANDARD** ourselves. How do we know which **STANDARD** is right? Well, because $\mathcal{COD'}$ our Creator has set the **STANDARD** or rules that we must live by. So, where do we find $\mathcal{COD'S}$ righteous **STANDARD**?

COD has given us His STANDARD in the BIBLE, His principles or rules that we are to live by. If we live according to COD'S right STANDARD (His principles or rules) then our lives



a life that is pleasing to COD.

So, how do we live a right life, a life that is pleasing to COD? And what exactly is COD'S STANDARD for MY life?



As mentioned at the beginning, we are going to talk about the **PURPOSE** or reason that we are alive. When we know the **PURPOSE**, we will know the **STANDARD** by which we are to measure our lives by. We don't want to live our lives by the wrong **STANDARD**! We want to live our lives by the right **STANDARD** – COD'S **STANDARD**!

It's so important that we see ourselves as COD sees us. COD has told us in the BIBLE what His STANDARD is for our lives.




Logk up and read Colossians 1:16,

"For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him."

Now Logk up and read Colossians 1:9-10,

"For this reason we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to ask that you may be filled with the knowledge of this will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding: that you may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing thim, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God."



Now, let's LOGK at the second WORD in *Isalah 43*:7, which is the WORD "FORMED". This WORD indicates a process. This WORD is the same WORD that would be used of the potter at work at his potter's wheel.

"Every one that is called by My name, and whom I have created for My glory" I have **formed** him; yes, I have made him." Isaiah 4.3:7

> Do you know what a potter's wheel is used for? It is used to make pottery. A potter's wheel cannot **GREATE** the CLAY and then make a vase or bowl. The potter takes the CLAY that already exists, and uses the wheel to form the CLAY into a useful vessel.

> > By manipulation of things already existing, a new thing is **MADE** to be.

The (LAY already exists. The potter just takes the already existing (LAY and then makes a new thing out of it.

The third word, "MADE", is a word that indicates the "out look" or the "result"; "I have MADE", "I have accomplished", "I have finished".

Every one that is called by My name, and whom I have created for My glory: I have formed him: yes, I have **made** him." Isaiah 4.3:7

TILE IS ALLESCHEE Man, in all of his complex nature, is a thought of *cop*, a WORD of *cop*, a **GREATION** of *cop*! As we **LOOK** at our world, we see that man has invented and **MADE** improvements, that man has manipulated things that already exist and makes new things from them. Man can only take existing materials **GREATED**

by COD and make (fashion) something new from them. But, he cannot GREATE something out of nothing as only COD can!

The only answer we have for **GREATION** is what COD has said, "I have created." COD has **GREATED** us. Do you **BELIEVE** that? Only COD has actually **GREATED** things out of nothing!



Now, here's the great problem in life! So many people do not understand or BELIEVE that COD GREATED them and that He has a **PURPOSE** for their lives. Because of this, they don't live by COD'S STANDARD; they live by the wrong STANDARD!

This leads us to the last consideration in Isaiah 43:7 which tells us that GOD has GREATED us for His glory.

Many people do not know this. Do you know this? Do you BELIEVE this?

COD says, "Whom I have created for My glory." So, what does it mean to be "GREATED for COD'S glory"?

Go ahead and read (Corinthians 10:31. What are you to do?

"Therefore, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God." 1 Corinthians 10:31

> ARE YOU SO... WHAT TO DO? TO GLORIFY GOD?

It means to bring Him **HONOR** through how we th _ _k, and what we s _ y, and how we a _ t.

To GLORIFY COD means to **HONOR** Him in our thoughts, words, and ACTIONS and to value Him above all things. To GLORIFY COD means to have a heartfelt thankfulness to Him.


We GLORIFY COD through our **FAITH** (**TRUST**) in Him. We GLORIFY COD through our LOVE for him. We GLORIFY COD through our Obedience to Him. We GLORIFY COD through our $\Delta ESITE$ to know Him.

WHAT

It's important to understand that we were **GREATED** to know COD. Man has a consciousness of COD, which no other being has, because COD wants to have a personal **relationship** with us.

COD wants us to please Him by our **TRUST** (**FAITH**) in Him.

<u>Pleasing COD</u> is the very **PURPOSE** of our existence and the BIBLE says that we delight COD'S heart through **FAITH** in Him. We are not to live to please ourselves. We are to live to please COD. We were **GREATED** for COD'S pleasure.



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destination to where it was found 15 years later, ditched in the Sahara Desert of North Africa. What had happened? On that night, an unusually strong tail wind caused the bomber and its crew to reach the coast of North Africa several hours ahead of schedule. When their flight instruments indicated that they had flown far enough to reach their destination, the men just could not believe it! They thought it was simply impossible to fly that great distance in so short a time. Coming to the conclusion that the enemy was jamming their instruments, or that the instruments were just malfunctioning, the officer in charge made the decision to continue. That decision cost the crew their lives. When the plane was finally out of fuel, the crew parachuted out at night and the plane crashed in the Sahara Desert of North Africa. You can imagine what went through their minds as they looked around the next morning in the heat of the scorching sun, surrounded by sand as far as the eye could see. All they could do was try to walk out ...

and they died doing so.

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WHAT went wrong? Those nine men did not BELIEVE and act upon the plane's "STANDARD." The tragedy is that the instruments gave them all the signals they needed to find their way safely home while they still had plenty of fuel to get there. The information displayed on the flight instruments was true. They simply did not BELIEVE and act upon their "STANDARD." But, what about us? Will we ignore COD'S STANDARD, the BIBLE, and just live any way we want to? Not living according to COD'S STANDARD will never have a good outcome.

In some up-and-coming *stUDIEs* we will talk more about the **DEFINITION** of **FAITH** in depth, but for now, let's read it together.

DEFINITION: "FAITH is BELIEVING COD'S WORD and ACTING upon it, no matter how I feel, because COD promises a GOOD RESULT."

The BIBLE verse for this stUDY is Nebrews 11:6. Go ahead and read it out loud together.




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

FAITH is the message of the BIBLE, FAITH in a COD who can be TRUSTED! What does


it mean to

- **FIRM RELIANCE** (What does firm reliance mean?) Placing CONFIDENCE in someone TRUST?
 - BELIEF

 - **TRUST WORTHINESS** or reliability of a person (*What's that mean?*) Dependence
 - BELIEVING things will turn out well in the end.

These are some different meanings of **TRUST**. Can you think of any more?

Isn't it wonderful that COD can be **TRUSTED**? Perhaps you don't BELIEVE that anyone can be **TRUSTED** because of things that have happened in your life, but there is someone who is absolutely **TRUST WORTHY** and you can **TRUST** Him! He is Jesus the Christ.




Have you discovered that He is **TRUSTWORTHY**? How? Sometimes it is hard to **TRUST** people, because often we get let down, lied to, and we can't depend on what people tell us.

It seems pretty obvious that what is meant is that we cannot please *COD* apart from **FAITH**.

Let's read it again. "But without **FAITH** it is impossible to please Him..."

There are times when we read or hear something and think it says something different than what it says. We need to be careful to understand what \mathcal{COD} is saying here.

 \bigcirc says that without **FAITTH** it is impossible to please Him. By impossible it <u>does not</u> mean it is difficult to please \bigcirc . And it does not mean it's hard or unlikely to please Him.

> It is very clear and plain that without **FAITH** it is impossible to please *COP*!




Yet, some people have a very hard time BELIEVING that without FAITH it is impossible to please COD. Bf, without FAITH you can't please COD.

> So, do you know what they try to do instead of **FAITH**? They try to please *COD* in other ways, by works, which means they try to do things for *COD* to try to please Him.



It's IMPOSSIBLE to please COD apart from FAITH. COD loves the fact that you **TRUST** Him and have FAITH in Him. We read about **FAITH** everywhere in the BIBLE. Let's read some verses from the BIBLE about **FAITH**.



In 2 Corinthians 5:7 it says, "For we walk by faith..." **FAILTH** is the way to walk with COD, which means a day-by-day relationship with the Lord. How can we have this day-by-day relationship with COD? We have it by walking by **FAILTH** (**TRUSTING** in COD). What are some ways that enable us to daily walk with COD?




"For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, not of works, lest anyone should boast." Ephesians 2:8

Do you realize how wonderful

CODES gift of salvation is! We cannot work to get it. It is CODES gift to us when we have **FAITH** in Him and **TRUST** Him with our lives.

Well, we know that everyone has troubles. Even children have troubles. We read in the BIBLE about a man named Daniel who **TRUSTED** COP very much, even in troubles. In fact, Daniel had learned to **TRUST** in COP when he was a young person. You can learn to **TRUST** in COP too!


Here's a TRUE STORY from the BIBLE about how Daniel TRUSTED GOD who is TRUSTWORTHY!

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Daniel was a man who loved God. He had been taken captive to a foreign country many years before. But, in spite of the hardships of being stolen and now living in a new and different land, he still trusted God in every part of his life. One such time is recorded in the Bible so that we can learn from his Godly example. The king of the country, King Darius, liked Daniel and saw that he was FAITHFUL. The Lord blessed Daniel by prompting King Darius to set him over part of the kingdom and giving him more authority and power. The other governors were jealous of Daniel. These governors looked for something wrong in Daniel in order to trap him, but they could find nothing wrong.

They finally decided that the one area of his life they could trap him in was "concerning the law of his God." They knew he would not back down from his belief in God, so these men found a way to get the king involved in their evil trick. They came to the king and asked him to sign a law which stated, "that for 30 days no one could petition (ask anything of) any God or man except for the king, and if they did they would be thrown into the den of lions." Well, you guessed it; the king signed it! But, the Bible says that when Daniel knew that the


Maybe you've been faced with the challenge of not **TRUSTING** *COP* and to not continue obeying His WORD because people are pressuring you and trying to trick you in some way. Maybe you've been tempted at school or somewhere else when you sit down to eat lunch, not to pray and give thanks to *COP* because of what others might think. When you are tempted in an area like that, remember Daniel and his example of **TRUSTING** in *COP*. Remember *COP* promises a **GOOD RESULT** to those who place their **FAITTH** and **TRUST** in Him!

So, **FAITH** is active confidence in COD. Daniel had active confidence in COD.

OK. Do you remember from our **L**ST BIBLE StUDY why you were **GREATED**? What's the answer? Many people don't know why they were **GREATED**. You need to know. You've been **GREATED** for *COD'S* glory.





FAITH starts with a choice. My mind thinks about information I have. My will chooses where to place my **TRUST**. Everybody **TRUSTS** in something or someone. Think about that! We all **TRUST** in something. We all have **FAITH** in something or someone.


We use **FAITH** all the time. People who don't **TRUST** COD still **TRUST** in something. They just unfortunately (for them), put their **TRUST** in something other - than GOD. But, they still have FAITH in something too, just not the one who can save them from their SINS. People who don't **TRUST** in COD often make fun of those who have FAITH in COD, who TRUST in COD. It doesn't make sense, because they too have **FAITH** in something. They also **TRUST** in something for their lives. They **TRUST** in money, power, science, education, church, family, and friends, etc. Talk about how we show TRUST and FAITH List ways we show **TRUST** and **FAITH**: 1. 2.

This may help you – what do you rely upon? What do you depend on? What do you BELIEVE in? What do you put your confidence in? What are you committed to? THIS IS WHAT YOU TRUST!

This is what happens when we show **FAITTH**. Our mind thinks about the possibilities; what will I put my **TRUST** in?

My mind thinks, "Who or what is worthy of my **TRUST**?" Then my will chooses, and the emotions follow. If it was a good choice, then good emotions follow. If it was a bad choice, then bad emotions follow.

So **FAITTH** is $A_T_{-} C_N F_{-} C E in COD;$ we choose to **TRUST**, we choose to **BELIEVE**.




COD knows that when our **FAITH** in Him is strong, we come to Him. And when our **FAITH** in Him is weak, we don't come to Him.

COD wants you to have FAITH. COD loves you so much and He knows that if you don't BELIEVE in Him and TRUST Him and have FAITH in Him, you will not come to Him.

In the Ist StUDY we considered why COD MADE us. It was to GLORIFY Him, to know Him and to fellowship with Him, to come to COD.

> And if you don't walk by **FAITTH**, then you won't come to Him. If you don't come to Him, then that means you're **TRUSTING** in something else to help you through life.

Bd, we know that COD is the ONLY One that can really help us get through life because COD has the power to work in our hearts and in the circumstances of our lives.





FAITH is so important with our relationship with COD and here's why; You cannot have a close relationship with COD if you don't **TRUST** Him.



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Here's a REAL LIFE example of three young men who proved their FAITH in God by their active confidence in Him.



The answer is yes! They BELIEVED COD'S WORD to worship only COD. They acted upon it by standing while everybody around them bowed down.

They did this even when they didn't Seel like it. You can be sure they didn't Seel like being thrown into fire! They did this because COD promised a **GOOD RESULT** that He would be **FAITTH FUL** to them, and He was! He saved them and didn't allow them to be hurt by the fire. Don't you want your **FAITTH** in COD to be active like that of these three young men?



That's responding to *COD* and what He said in His WORD, the BIBLE.

You can ask yourself the question, "What did God say in what I just read in the Bible that I can respond back to Him?" You can also answer questions like, "Is there a promise to claim?" And, "Is there a warning to heed?" Other questions would be, "Is there a command to obey?" or "Is there a good example to follow?" You can respond back to COD in prayer every time you read the BIBLE. That way you and COD are having a **TWO-WAY conversation!**

Don't forget! COD wants to have fellowship with you! COD wants to talk with you.


When you read the BIBLE and respond to what *COP* has said, you need to respond personally and correctly; personally, like responding to what a friend has just said to you, and correctly, not changing anything that the BIBLE says, but responding to what was said.





The next thing you need to do is:



You may have **WRONG** views about *COD*.

The way you think about COD may cause you to not want to spend any time with Him. It's not COD'S fault, it's your wrong thinking! Your views may be so wrong about COD that you don't want to know Him.

Maybe someone has said things about COD that are not true, which causes you to not care about COD. And because of what someone says that is wrong, that causes you to not want to come to COD.

If you have a wrong concept about *COD*, you probably won't come to Him. You don't want to spend time with "your idea" of *COD*. But that's not the way *COD* REALLY is, just the way you THINK He is.

So, what are some of the wrong ideas about COD that people might think? We often BELIEVE other people's ideas about COD because we have not LOSKED to see what COD says about Himself in His WORD, the BIBLE.

Think about this. Would you want to go to *COD* with any of these wrong ideas about Him?



IDEA #1

COD IS MEAN: Rules, rules, rules, and if we don't obey His rules we'll get in trouble. COD is no fun, He has no joy, and He never smiles. He is always serious and harsh.

Do any of you think that COD is like this?

COD IS NO FUN: He never wants anyone to have fun or enjoy themselves. He always goes around LOSKING for anyone who is having fun and tries to stop them.

Well, the reward is Him! He is the reward. If you come to Him and say, "God I trust You, I want You to be part of my life. I want to know Your strength. I want to fellowship with You and understand the reason why You placed me here on this earth."

Then COD says, "You will know Me, I will be found."

You must $B \in L \in V \in$ this or you will not come. $C \cap D$ can be known personally as a friend. He wants fellowship with you, but this is done by **FAITTH**.

There is nothing about *COD* that makes it impossible for people to BELIEVE. The difficulty is with the human will. Are you willing?

If you haven't come to COD by **FAITH**, now would be a good time to do that.



Would you like to start a *velationship* with *COD* **RIGHT NOW**? In Acts 16:31 we read that we need to BELIEVE (TRUST and have FAITTH) on the Lord *Jesus Christ*, and you will be saved.

What are we saved from? We are saved from our SIN. SIN causes spiritual death (separation from COD). But, 1 John 1:9 states that "if we confess our sin God is faithful to forgive us the sins we commit".

Asking CODE forgiveness, by **FAITH** BELIEVING COD has forgiven us, and committing our life to the Lord, to guide us and help us through life is what is called being "born again." (John 3) This is what **TRUSTING** in COD is all about. Do you think you have to be super knowledgeable, powerful, or spiritual to have **FAITH** in *COD*? Sometimes we can think that it's only superior people who have **FAITH**.

Ba, that's not so! The people named in Nebrews 11 were ordinary people who accomplished great things.

GIDEON was a frightened farmer when COD called him. MOSES was a fugitive from justice.


JEPHTHAH was an illegitimate son, unwanted by his family.

They are there because they could <u>not</u> do great things, so they **TRUSTED** COD to do great things for them!


FAITH is confidence in the **TRUSTWORTHINESS** of COD. It is the conviction or belief that what COD says is true and that what He promises will come to pass.



To BELIEVE in spite of evidence is really superstition, not FAITH, because FAITH is only as good as the object (what then are you **TRUSTING** in?). And the object of a CHRISTIAN'S FAITH is *Jesus Christ*, in who He is, and what He did on earth.

And if we don't act upon what the BIBLE says, then we really don't BELIEVE.


WALK THE TALK Many people agree in their mind with what the BIBLE says but because they don't act upon what He says, it means that they really don't BELIEVE with their heart.

There will be times when we are confused, scared, sad, happy, sick, discouraged and the list could go on and on. We cannot depend on just how we feel to help us make a decision to obey \mathcal{COD} .



Feelings should not influence our choices as we walk in FAITTH with COD. Sometimes we don't feel like doing what it says to do in the BIBLE, but we will still act upon what COD has said and do it.

That's called living by **FAITH**, **TRUSTING** COD.

Many people live by Seelings and if they don't Seel like doing something, they won't. And there are many people that won't act in **FAITTH** because they depend on their Seelings to guide them in their decision to obey or not to obey. That is a great hindrance to walking by **FAITTH**. COD wants us to **TRUST** in Him and walk by **FAITTH**, no matter how we Seel.

There are many stories in the BIBLE of people who had to make a decision to **TRUST** the Lord in spite of how they felt.

We BELIEVE that what GOD says is true. GOD cannot lie, so when He tells us something in His WORD, we can BELIEVE it.

We will do what's right because we BELIEVE the WORD of COD and we're ACTING upon it, when we feel like it and when we don't feel like it, because COD promises a GOOD RESULT.

 \bigcirc promises that all things work together for the good for those who *love* Him. Do you *love* Him? If you *love* Him, then this promise is meant for you!

By, that doesn't mean that all things will be good in our lives; bad things do happen. But if you *love* Him, He promises a **GOOD RESULT**, that good will come from those bad situations that happen in our lives. And if we have patience we will

see how COD causes the bad things that happen in our lives to work for the good, because He loves us!

We're not careful, we'll miss it! This is the CHRISTIAN life, this is what following COD is all about.

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Why do you think the demons "tremble"? To tremble means to be troubled by fear. These creatures **BELIEVE**, not only in **GOD'S** existence, but also in His power. They do not *love* and serve **GOD**. They have an understanding of who **GOD** is and that causes them to tremble!

So it is with many people! They may have a "head" belief about who **GOP** is, but they haven't given their lives (hearts) to Him and do not serve Him.

James is trying to communicate that head-belief is good, but it is heart-belief that is necessary for salvation. Let's think about that!






Here are two little stories that hopefully will help you understand this idea of **BELIEF**.

There was a man back in the 1800's whose name was Charles Blondin. He was a French tightrope walker. One of Charles Blondin's greatest accomplishments was in June of 1859 when he attempted to become the first person to walk a tightrope that stretched over a quarter of a mile across the mighty Niagara Falls. He walked across 160 feet above the falls several times, each time doing a different daring ACT - once in a sack, once on stilts, once on a bicycle, once in the dark, and once he even carried a stove and cooked an omelet! On one occasion Blondin was waiting to perform across

the tightrope again, when he noticed a young boy standing by, excited and curious with interest. Addressing the boy and pointing up to the rope, Mr. Blondin said, "Do you BELIEVE I can walk across that rope?" "Yes, I do," was the boy's reply. Mr. Blondin asked another question, "Do you BELIEVE I could carry you on my back and walk across?" Unhesitatingly came the answer "Yes, I do!" Charles Blondin bent down and replied, "All right! Jump up!" But the boy disappeared!

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He had said that he had **BELIEVED**, but did he really? What kind of belief did this boy have? Was it a head belief or a heart belief?

A grocer was down in the cellar (basement) of his shop, when he noticed his small son standing at the open trap door. He called up, "Here I am, son, jump down". But the boy hesitated. "I can't, Daddy. I can't see you," he said. His father answered, "Trust me and jump and I will catch you." At his father's words, the boy jumped, because he believed his father.

To BELIEVE is to **TRUST**, to place full confidence in, to rest upon with **FAITH**.



The first two kinds of belief we Lo KED at were only "head belief." They were beliefs that did not involve **TRUST**. But, the third kind of belief was a "heart belief" because it involved **TRUST** and ACTION. The young boy in the first story displayed only "head belief". He was not willing to **TRUST** Mr. Blondin to carry him across the tightrope. He didn't REALLY BELIEVE. But the grocer's son had a "heart belief "in his father when he jumped into his arms even though he couldn't see him. He **TRUSTED** his father.

FAITH is BELIEVING CODE WORD because **TRUSTING** what someone says is the same as **TRUSTING** that person. Some may say, "Well, I BELIEVE GOD, I just don't BELIEVE anything He says." THIS CREAT




So, **TRUSTING** what a person says, and **TRUSTING** a person is the same thing. **FAITH** is BELIEVING what **GOD** says! **GOD** and His WORD are **TRUST WORTHY**!

> **GOD** has things to say to each one of us. He has said some things about what He is like. **GOD** has said some things to us about how He Seels. GOD has said some things about how He will ACT in certain situations. GOD has said, that if certain conditions are met Nand we do what He says to do, then He will do certain things. **GOD** has said some things.

FANTH is **BELIEVING** what **GOD** has said.

Let's read again in Titw 1:2 about something GOP has said.



Notice that it says, "GOD cannot lie." It doesn't say, GOD won't lie, or that GOD doesn't lie. It says, "GOD cannot lie." Everything that He says is true, and therefore **TRUSTWORTHY**.

This is something GOP has said. Let's read John 3:16-17.

"For God so loved the world that the gave this only begotten Son, that whoever believes in thim should not perish but have everlasting life. For God did not send this Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Nim might be saved."

Do you BELIEVE what **GOD** has said here in John 3:16-17? \Box **Yes** \Box **No**

Let's consider the meaning of the word **TRUST**, which is very much the same as the words **BELIEVE** and **FAITH**. When it comes to a *relationship* with **GOD**, this is a very important word.

We know from our last StUDY that the word "BELIEVE" can be used in different ways and sometimes has to do with BELIEVING only in our heads and not in our hearts. A head-belief is only a mental process. But, we can BELIEVE and know about Jesus Christ and still not be saved.

When the **APOSTLE PAUL** and **SILAS** were in jail and the Philippian jailer asked the question, "What Must I do to be saved?" the answer in The NEV BIBLE is, "Put your trust in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved" (Acts 16:30-31).

It has nothing whatsoever to do with the intellect (BELIEVING in your head only); it has to do with the will (what we choose to do), and demands a decision. There are multitudes (lots of people) that "BELIEVE", but have never put their "TRUST" in Jesus Christ.



So, since to be saved, we must **BELIEVE** in (**TRUST**) *Jesus*, don't you think it would be extremely important to understand what it means to **TRUST** someone.

1 it excludes effort. It's similar to floating on water. Have you ever floated on water? If you have, then you know that the water can hold up your weight. All you have to do is to **TRUST** the water.

In **TRUSTING** *GOD*, you need to put aside your effort, your fear, and your doubts. It won't work to try to help yourself either by works or religion (trying to do good things to make yourself acceptable to *GOD*). Just float. (Don't try to help *GOD* out, just **TRUST** Him!) As long as you are putting forth effort you are not **TRUSTING**.

NUD, trust leads to commitment. TRUST means to give yourself over, to commit yourself, to TRUST the Lord. It is possible to BELIEVE as much as you want to BELIEVE and still not be saved. But, the moment you give yourself up to Jesus Christ, the moment you commit yourself to Him, the moment you put your TRUST in Him, you are saved, but not until then.

Have you ever done that? Have you ever committed yourself to the Lord?

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The 3 RD is trust requires action. REMEMBER the story of Blondin, the tightrope walker? There's another part of the story that goes like this:

On August 17, 1859, about 25,000 thrillseekers arrived by train and steamer and dispersed on the American or Canadian side of the falls. Both banks grew with swarms of spectators, among them statesmen, judges, clerics, generals, members of Congress, capitalists, artists, newspaper editors, professors, debutantes, and salesmen. Vendors hawked everything from lemonade to merchandise, and Colcord (Blondin's Manager) gave tours to the press, explaining the logistics of what the Great Charles Blondin was about to attempt. As he explained, "A rope 1,300 feet long, two inches in diameter and made entirely of hemp would be the sole thing separating him from the roiling waters below."

As the crowd of people watched eagerly, the great tightrope walker, Blondin, stepped onto the rope. The crowds were hushed as he started across balancing his 40-pound pole. As he triumphantly reached the other side, a great cheer arose above the deafening roar of the mighty falls.

Turning to the crowd, he now said an amazing statement. He offered to re-cross the rope, high above the waters below, carrying a man on his back. But, no one was willing to do it. He then turned to his manager, Henry Colcord, and asked,

"Do you believe I can carry you across?"

"I believe. In fact, I have no doubt about it at all," answered Colcord.


"Will you Trust me?"

"I will!"



And that is what both Blondin and Colcord did. They crossed over to the other side.





Well, that's exactly what Blondin's manager, Colcord did. He **BELIEVED** what Blondin said, then he **ACTED** upon it by getting on Blondin's back as he walked across on the tightrope, crossing the Nigara Falls.

> Why could Colcord be so brave? Because he **TRUSTED** in Blondin! He put his **FAITH** in him, **BELIEVING** that he could do what he said he could do. That's **TRUSTING**!

> > How important it is to put our **TRUST** in Jesus Christ. Will you **TRUST** Him with your life? Or will you merely **BELIEVE** with your head?

Will you, by a definite ACT of your will, put your TRUST in the Lord?

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Remember what the Philippian jailer asked, "What must I do to be saved?" And the answer is, put your **TRUST** in the Lord!

How do we know that we BELIEVE what GOP has said? The answer is in the second part of the DEFINITION of FAMTH; "...and ACTING upon it..."

You know that you BELIEVE GOD'S WORD and that you **TRUST** Him, when you ACT upon it.

Would anyone like to ACT uponGOD'S WORD now, and pray to putyour TRUST in the Lord?

He loveS you so much. He died on the cross and took the punishment for your *SINS* so you could have your *SINS* forgiven and have a wonderful **elotionship** and fellowship with *GOD*. Who wouldn't want to be born-again? It's like *GOD* gives us a new heart, on the inside – He forgives our *SINS* and enables us to live a new kind of life – a life that is pleasing to *GOD*. He gives us peace, joy, *love*, and His Holy Spirit to enable us to live every day in a way that pleases Him. He is so good to us! Don't YOU want to *love* this wonderful Savior? You will always be glad that you **MADE** the decision to give your life to Him, to put your **TRUST** in Him. You will be glad now, while you live on the e______h. You'll be glad later when you can live with *GOD* in H______n.

Will you BELIEVE what GOD has said in Romans 3:23? Logk it up and read it. Do you BELIEVE that?





Walking also implies closeness and fellowship.

Walking with a friend is a time to talk, to get to know one another, and to share the things that are happening in our lives.

Walking with **GOD** is a daily process of growing closer to Him, as we share everything in our lives with Him, and learn more of His ways.

We must do our own walking. Someone else cannot do it for us.

We need to take the initiative, the time, and the effort that is required to walk with GOD.

FAITH says "I will meet with You this morning before I go to school."
FAITH says, "I will make an appointment to meet with God alone."
FAITH says, "I will read God's Word and respond personally to Him."
FAITH says, "I will read God's Word and memorize it."
FAITH is a daily dependence on GOD, step by step, that continues over a lifetime.

If you walk with **GOD** by **FAITH**, your life is pleasing to Him. Even if you go through terrible trails, you can **TRUST** that **GOD** is with you. Let's take the **DEFINITION** of **FAITH** and apply it to Matthew 6:25-34 "FAITH is BELIEVING CODE WORD and ACTING upon it, no matter how I Seel, because COD promises a GOOD RESULT." Let's read together Matthew 6:25-34.

"Therefore I say to you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat or what you will drink; nor about your body, what you will put on. Is not life more than food and the body more than clothing? Look at the birds of the air, for they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of more value than they? Which of you by worrying can add one cubit to his stature? So why do you worry about clothing? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow: they neither toil nor spin; and yet I say to you that even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these. Now if God so clothes the grass of the field, which today is, and tomorrow is thrown into the oven, will the not much more clothe you, O you of little faith? Therefore do not worry, saying, What shall we eat? or What shall we drink? or What shall we wear? For after all these things the Gentiles seek. For your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things. But seek first the kingdom of God and this righteowness, and all these things shall be added to you. Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about its own things. Sufficient for the day is its own trouble."

Worry doesn't change anything! Let's all say it together. *"Worry doesn't change anything!"* **Do you worry?**

You can't make anything different just because you choose to worry about it.

How many times in Matthew 6:25-34 does **GOD** tell us not to worry?


So, that must mean that **GOP** does not want us to worry! **GOP** usually doesn't repeat Himself unless He really wants us to clearly understand something.

What part of the **FAITH** <u>DEFINITION</u> does, "don't worry" apply to?

The first part, and what does the first part of the **DEFINITION** say? Write it out.

When we choose not to **BELIEVE GOD'S** WORD, problems happen. Such as if we don't **BELIEVE** what **GOD** says about worry, then we find that worry will choke out the life in us. It doesn't change a thing.





Worry sends a terrible message to GOD. It says, "God, I don't matter to You." That's what we're saying when we worry. It says, "I don't matter to You as much as a bunch of birds."
(Matthew 6:26) GOD takes care of the birds on a daily basis, but what about me? GOD wants us to do something instead of worrying! GOD says in (Jke 18:1 and I Thess. 5:17 that he wants us to pray! He wants us to take our troubles and our concerns to Him in prayer. He wants us to talk to Him about everything! "Do not worry about anything, but pray about everything." Talk to GOD about everything.

We must remember what He says right after that. "Are you not of More value than they?" We are valuable to **GOD**. You are valuable to **GOD**. **GOD** provides for the birds on a daily basis, how much more will He for us.

LOSK at what Matthew 10:29-31 says.

"Are not two sparrows sold for a copper coin? And not one of them falls to the ground apart from your Father's will. But the very hairs of your head are all numbered. Do not fear therefore; you are of more value than many sparrows." "Consider the lilies of the field,

how they grow: they neither toil nor spin; and yet I say to you that even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these. Now if God so clothes the grass of the field, which today is, and tomorrow is thrown into the oven, will the not much more clothe you..."



GOD cares for you. If **GOD** cares for the flowers, don't you think He is going to take care of you? Will He not MUCH MORE clothe you, and take care of you?




Verse 31 says, "Therefore do not worry, saying, What shall we eat? or What shall we drink? or What shall we wear? For after all these things the Gentiles seek." This is what the Gentiles say. That's the life of a person who doesn't know **GOD**. That's what they spend their time thinking about.

But, your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things.

GOD knows! Don't even think **GOD** doesn't know! Your idea of **GOD** is too small if you really think **GOD** doesn't know.

GOD wants us to **TRUST** Him and to have **FAITH** in Him. So, how do we win over worry?

FIRST, confess it as *SIN* and repent. (We will often try to rationalize that everybody worries. We try to explain it away.)



The **THIRD** thing is to **ACT** upon it, no matter how you See). The **ACT** part of **FAITH** is found in verse 33. "But seek first the kingdom of God and Nis righteowness..." The first thing to do is get involved with doing something for the kingdom of **GOD** (serve **GOD**). Stop thinking just about yourself.

And, "His righteowness" being serious about the person **GOP** wants you to be. Allow **GOP** to work in your life, changing you more into the likeness of His Son.

TRUST GOD one day at a time!

Pray this if you agree with it:



"God, I trust You with my tomorrow. I don't know what's ahead, but You do! I don't know how I'll manage, but You know. Thank you God for enough strength for today. I will not worry about tomorrow and I won't let worry choke the joy out of today. God, I choose to focus on what really matters. I confess the sin of worry, and I receive Your forgiveness. Lord, I believe I do matter to You. Lord, I believe You're committed to me and You know my needs. Lord, one day at a time, I'm Trusting You with my future. Help me to seek You first and make me a boy or girl of faith. In Jesus' name, Amen." Well, we've learned that the **PURP9SE** of **FAITH** is to please **GOD**. Everything in the life of **FAITH** is a by-product of our *desire* to please **GOD**. If we want to please **GOD**, we will come to **GOD**. This means fellowship; spending time in His WORD and responding in prayer to what He has said.

Hebrews 11:6, indicates that this relationship involves not only pleasing **GOD** and coming to **GOD**, but also seeking **GOD**. This implies a deep $d \in Sir \in$ to know Him better and to please Him more. That's a good thing to pray about.




