

Okay, here they are! The first one is an easy one!



BELIEVE This means that you have to that @OD is BELIEVE that @OD really does exist.

Psalm 14:1 says,

The fool has said in his heart, 'there is no God."



It's no wonder that in the BIBLE, Psalm 14:1 says "The fool has said in his heart, 'there is no God." This person, the fool, doesn't really BELIEVE that there is no ¿OD, he just says it to himself in his heart. He just keeps trying to convince himself over and over again that there is no *GOD*.

Everyone knows that there is a COD, a CREATOR. Even the person who has had no contact with a missionary or anyone to explain what the BIBLE is or what it says, KNOWS there is a GOD!

Just **Looking** up at the sparkling stars in the night sky convinces them that there is a CREATOR.

Do you know what an atheist is? Atheists say that they don't BELIEVE that there is a COD, but atheism is a learned behavior. People must be taught to BELIEVE something so foolish.

We don't want to be fools, do we? You don't want to be a fool, do you? So, the first thing you have to do is to BELIEVE that COD exists.

The next thing you need to do is:

BELIEVE in COD for who He really is

You may have **WRONG** views about \mathcal{COD} .

The way you think about @@D may cause you to not want to spend any time with Him. It's not @@D'S fault, it's your wrong thinking! Your views may be so wrong about @@D that you don't want to know Him.

Maybe someone has said things about @@D that are not true, which causes you to not care about @@D. And because of what someone says that is wrong, that causes you to not want to come to @@D.

If you have a wrong concept about @@D, you probably won't come to Him. You don't want to spend time with "your idea" of @@D. But that's not the way @@D REALLY is, just the way you

So, what are some of the wrong ideas about @@D that people might think? We often BELIEVE other people's ideas about @@D because we have not LogKED to see what @@D says about Himself in His WORD, the BIBLE.

Think about this. Would you want to go to @@D with any of these wrong ideas about Him?



IIDEA #1

COD IS MEAN: Rules, rules, rules, and if we don't obey His rules we'll get in trouble. **COD** is no fun, He has no joy, and He never smiles. He is always serious and harsh.

Do any of you think that @@D is like this?

IIIDIEA #22

© IS NO FUN: He never wants anyone to have fun or enjoy themselves. He always goes around **Locking** for anyone who is having fun and tries to stop them.

IIDIEA #3

COD HAS FAVORITES: He likes some people more than others, and treats some people more special than other people.

Well, if you think @@D is like any of these ideas, you probably won't want to come to Him. Who would? Those are wrong ideas that people have come up with about @@D. BB @@DS WORD, the BIBLE, tells us the truth about who @@D really is and what He is really like.

We will not come to COD if we doubt His existence.


Again, Nebrews 11:6 states, "But without faith it is impossible to please Nim, for he who comesto God must believe that he is, and that He is..."

This means you must BELIEVE that @@D is who the BIBLE reveals Him to be. FAITTH holds on, BELIEVING that @@D is!

Let's **L**OSK at some verses that tell us a little about @OD, and the truth about who @OD is.

This means He is without limitations, without beginning or ending. It means He will be @@D forever and ever! Isn't that amazing?

This means that @@D doesn't change! Can you think of anything else that doesn't change? It seems that everything else is always changing. Bd @@D never changes!

When @@D says He will never leave His children, (those who follow Him) He means it.




