REMEMBER, in the last STUDY we said that we would talk about what the reward is for seeking @@D.

WHAT IS A REWARD?

Losk up and fill in the blanks, then read out loud Genesis 15:1

"After these things the word of the _____ came to Abram in a vision, saying, Do not be afraid, Abram. I am your shield, your exceedingly ____ reward."

Well, the reward is Him! He is the reward. If you come to Him and say, "God I trust You, I want You to be part of my life. I want to know Your strength. I want to fellowship with You and understand the reason why You placed me here on this earth."

Then @OD says, "You will know Me, I will be found."

You must BELIEVE this or you will not come. @@D can be known personally as a friend. He wants fellowship with you, but this is done by FAITH.

There is nothing about @@D that makes it impossible for people to BELIEVE.
The difficulty is with the human will.
Are you willing?

If you haven't come to **COD** by **FAITTH**, now would be a good time to do that.

Would you like to start a relationship with COD RIGHT NOW?

In Acts 16:31 we read that we need to BELIEVE (TRUST and have

FAITH) on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be saved.

(LOOK AT "GOSPEL PAGE" IN THE LAST PAGE OF THIS LESSON)

What are we saved from? We are saved from our SIN. SIN causes spiritual death (separation from @@D). But, 1 John 1:9 states that "if we confess our sin God is faithful to forgive us the sins we commit".

Do you think you have to be super knowledgeable, powerful, or spiritual to have FAITH in @@D? Sometimes we can think that it's only superior people who have FAITH.


By, that's not so! The people named in Nebrews 11 were ordinary people who accomplished great things.

GIDEON was a frightened farmer when **GOD** called him. **MOSES** was a fugitive from justice.

JEPHTHAH was an illegitimate son, unwanted by his family.

They are there because they could <u>not</u> do great things, so they **TRUSTED COD** to do great things for them!


FAITH is confidence in the **TRUST WORTHINESS** of *COD*. It is the conviction or belief that what *COD* says is true and that what He promises will come to pass.



To BELIEVE in spite of evidence is really superstition, not FAITH, because FAITH is only as good as the object (what then are you **TRUSTING** in?).

And the object of a <code>OHRISTIAN</code>'s FAITH is *Jesus Christ*, in who He is, and what He did on earth.

Think about this... we have **FAITH** in the one who is the Creator, the One true **COD**, the One who can do anything, and the One who *loves* us! The One who is **TRUST WORTHY!**

and One Mediator between @@D and man, the Man Christ Jesus.

"For there is one GOD and one Mediator between GOD and men, the Man Christ Jesus." 1 Timothy 2:5

And *Jesus* said,

Hopefully you BELIEVE this and have come to GOD.

Let's LOSK closer at our **DEFINITION** of **FAILTIM**:

"FAITH is BELIEVING @OD'S WORD and ACTING upon it, no matter how I feel, because @OD promises a GOOD RESULT."



This is a great **DEFINITION** of **FAITH**. We have already learned that **FAITH** is active confidence in **@OD**, but this **DEFINITION** will help us understand even more what **FAITH** is.

Let's work on this **DEFINITION** together. There are **4** parts:

Let's use Pomans 8:28 from @@@\$ WORD to explain how this **DEFINITION** of **FAITH** works.

"And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to Nis purpose." Romans 8:28

We must BELIEVE what @OD has said and that it's true. We must have confidence in what @OD has said. You can know absolutely that all things are working together for good because you love Him (Do you love Him?) and have been called according to His PURPOSE.

That's what His WORD says. Do you BELIEVE @@D'S WORD? Some people BELIEVE the WORD of @@D and some people don't BELIEVE it. Their non-belief or belief will determine where they will spend eternity, either with @@D in Heaven or away from @@D in Hell. And away from @@D would be a bad choice. Now LOSK at the Part of the DEFINITION of FAITTH.

ACTING upon it means that we BELIEVE what GOD has said, and live according to what He has said in His WORD, the BIBLE.

When we BELIEVE it then we will act upon it. We will do what His WORD, the BIBLE, tells us to do. So, the way we know we BELIEVE is because we act upon what the BIBLE says.



And if we don't act upon what the BIBLE says, then we really don't BELIEVE.

WALK THE TALK!) Many people agree in their mind with what the BIBLE says but because they don't act upon what He says, it means that they really don't BELIEVE with their heart.

> So, do you BELIEVE what the BIBLE says that, "all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to this purpose?" If we do BELIEVE that, then we will act upon it and live according to what @OD has said.

There will be times when we are confused, scared, sad, happy, sick, discouraged and the list could go on and on. We cannot depend on just how we feel to help us make a decision to obey @@D.

Feelings should not influence our choices as we walk in **FAITH** with COD. Sometimes we don't feel like doing what it says to do in the BIBLE, but we will still act upon what GOD has said and do it.

That's called living by **FAITH**, **TRUSTING** COD.

Many people live by Seelings and if they don't feel like doing something, they won't. And there are many people that won't act in **FAITH** because they depend on their feelings to guide them in their decision to obey or not to obey. That is a great hindrance to walking by **FANTIH**. COD wants us to **TRUST** in Him and walk by FAITH, no matter how we feel.

There are many stories in the BIBLE of people who had to make a decision to **TRUST** the Lord in spite of how they felt.

We BELIEVE that what GOD says is true. GOD cannot lie, so when He tells us something in His WORD, we can BELIEVE it. We will do what's right because we BELIEVE the WORD of @OD and we're ACTING upon it, when we feel like it and when we don't feel like it, because **COD** promises a **GOOD RESULT**. COD promises that all things work together for the good for those who love Him. Do you love Him? If you love Him, then this promise is meant for you! I, that doesn't mean that all things will be good in our lives; bad things do happen. But if you love Him, He promises a GOOD RESULT, that good will come from those bad situations that happen in our lives. And if we have patience we will see how @@@ causes the bad things that happen in our lives to work for the good, because He loves us! isn't this simple? This is so simple that, if we're not careful, we'll miss it! This is the (י אודובדובא) life, this is what following @@D is all about. Again we read in Nebrews 11:6. But without faith it is impossible to please Nim, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him." 


