


We should relate to **GOD**, not because we are trying to be good enough for Him, but because of His **LOVE** for us and our **LOVE** for Him.

When we know the joy of **FELLOWSHIP** with **GOD**, we won't want ANY barriers or blocks to come between us!




As we experience **GOD'S LOVE** more and more in our lives, we find ourselves longing to please Him simply because we **LOVE** Him!






A DEAD-END RIGHTEOUSNESS:

How do you know what is right and what is wrong? Sometimes people just make up in their minds what are right things to do and what are wrong things.



THERE'S ONLY ONE PROBLEM:

We never live up to our own standard! So we make up all kinds of excuses why we failed! The most common excuse is that our failure isn't really our fault. None of us likes to accept the blame for what we've done.



This attitude goes all the way back to **ADAM**. He blamed his failure on **EVE**! Then **EVE** blamed the **SERPENT**!

THEN WHAT'S THE STANDARD?

Those who believe that they can be made acceptable to **GOD** without **JESUS** need to deal with some important questions.

If they believe that they can make it to heaven by trying to be good enough, what standard do they have to live up to?

What will God require of them?

So many say, "I feel that I am basically a kind and good person and I am willing to stand before God on my own goodness."



But, these people don't realize that **GOD'S** standards are different than ours.

JESUS showed us **GOD'S** requirement for those who would strive for heaven on their own power when He said...

If we are going to set up a standard of right living, **JESUS** **CHRIST** and how He lived, is our standard.

JESUS' life is the only standard of righteousness. If I want to be accepted by **GOD**, I must be as righteous as **JESUS** **CHRIST**.

So, if we want to stand before **GOD** on the basis of our own good works, we must live a life that measures up to the goodness we see in **ἸΗΣΟΥΣ**.




If we are ever to enjoy **FELLOWSHIP** with **GOD**, it will have to be on some basis other than our own righteousness.



WE CAN'T DO IT!

Our only hope is that another form of righteousness has been provided for us, a righteousness based on a totally different way other than our own works.

Thank **GOD**, there is such a way. It's called **GRACE**.




WHAT IS GRACE?



In the **NEW TESTAMENT**,

- **GRACE** means "**GOD'S** Undeserved Favor."
- **GRACE** is **GOD** giving to me something that I cannot earn on my own.
- **GRACE** is being accepted by **GOD** even though I do not deserve it, even though I am not worthy of it.




The **BIBLE** teaches...


How is it possible for me to be forgiven by **GOD**?




GOD'S basis of forgiveness is the sacrifice of His only begotten Son.

When **GOD** laid on **JESUS** the sin of us all, **CHRIST** received our deserved punishment, which the **BIBLE** declares is death.



There is **NO WAY** that I, by my good works, can ever make it to heaven. I am condemned because of my sin. I have no chance of being received by **GOD** apart from His mercy.

The good news is that **GOD** has made a way for me to be accepted by Him. How can I become a child of **GOD** and a part of **GOD'S** family?

When **JESUS** lived on the earth, there was a man named **NICODEMUS** who was a ruler of his people, the Jews. He wanted to find out more about **JESUS** so he came at night to talk to Him. **JESUS** told **NICODEMUS** that he had to be born again to belong to the family of **GOD**. **NICODEMUS** asked,



"How can a man be born when he is old? Can he enter the second time into his mother and be born?"

JESUS explained to **NICODEMUS** that a baby's birth is of the **flesh**. But **JESUS** was talking about a **spiritual** birth. When a person is born again, there is a work of **GOD'S Spirit** in his heart. **GOD** forgives his sins, and by His **Spirit** comes and indwells that person. That person changes and becomes a new creation because of the work of **GOD'S Spirit** in his life.




OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS IN CHRIST



Forgiveness is only half the story of the **GOSPEL OF GRACE!**

There are many people who believe **GOD** has forgiven us in **CHRIST**. Where they have trouble is the second half of the good news: that just by believing in **JESUS CHRIST**, **GOD** accounts us righteous!




My actions show me that I am not as good as I want to be, nevertheless, I am righteous before **GOD** and He looks at me as perfectly righteous because of my **FAITH** in **JESUS CHRIST**.

These are the **2** parts of the **GOSPEL OF GRACE**:



Why is that such **GOOD NEWS?**

BECAUSE I never need to fear and say,
"Oh, I can't go to God because I did something wrong."
But...



BECAUSE I have failed to achieve a certain standard, **SATAN** will try to keep me from coming to **GOD**!

He will say things like: You have no right to ask **GOD** to help you when you have just failed Him again. You know your action is displeasing to **GOD**, yet you did it anyway. Now, you're in trouble and you want **GOD** to help you. You think He is going to listen to you? No way!"


SATAN wants to make us think that **GOD** won't hear our prayers.



I have **NO** hope in my own self and in my own goodness.

But, I have great hope in the work that **JESUS CHRIST** did for me and in the work that **GOD** is doing in me by the power of his **Holy Spirit**. He is conforming me into the image of **CHRIST**!

But, if I am looking to **JESUS CHRIST** and I realize that I am accounted righteous because of my **FAITH** in **CHRIST**, **SATAN** can never keep me from **GOD**!



Those things that I cannot do for myself, He is doing for me. Those areas where I am so weak, He has made me strong. I have recognized my weakness and have cast myself upon Him. In those areas where I once was weak and constantly stumbling, I now stand strong because His strength has made me perfect in my weakness.

No matter how many good deeds we've done for Him,
no matter how many people we lead to Him, our only
glory is in **JESUS CHRIST**, who died for us.

Our righteousness is not a question of good
works, trying hard, or in keeping certain rules. Our
righteousness - both here, now, and for all eternity,
is a result of our simple **FAITH** in **GOD'S** Son, **JESUS**.



Sometimes I will feel that
my relationship with **GOD** is
good and at other times I will
feel it is bad. Why? Because
I am trying to relate to Him
on the basis of my own
righteousness!



If my relationship with **GOD** is dependent
on how I feel or how I am living or on my
own righteousness, I will not be able to
relate to **GOD** most of the time!

When my **RELATIONSHIP** with **GOD** is dependent upon **GOD'S GRACE** towards me, however, the door of blessing is never closed. **GOD'S** blessings are given on the basis of His **GRACE**, His undeserved favor.



I never deserve or earn a blessing. The blessings that come into my life are always dependent upon **GOD'S** undeserved favor to me. **GOD LOVES** me so much, He **blesses** me anyway. **GOD** is so good!




The **BIBLE** says that someone who places his **FAITH** in **JESUS CHRIST** has been "**JUSTIFIED**".



LOOK Up **ROMANS 10:9-10** again to see how we are "**JUSTIFIED**."

WHAT DOES THAT MEAN?

It means that **GOD** has granted us a standing before Him just as if we had never sinned. This was no small thing for **GOD** to accomplish! For if we have all sinned, how can **GOD** look at us as if we had never sinned and still be just?



How can He treat us as though we are perfect?

This is where the power of the Gospel comes in. **GOD** made the sinless **JESUS** to be sin for us. The **SCRIPTURES** declare that **GOD** laid on the innocent **CHRIST** the sins of us all. **JESUS** took my place and took the punishment that I deserved as a guilty sinner.


This is the glorious **GOSPEL OF GRACE** - our righteousness in **JESUS CHRIST** before **GOD**!

In **CHRIST**, I have an absolutely perfect righteous standing before **GOD**. In His eyes, I am perfect!

It is **AMAZING** to know and experience the **GRACE** of **GOD** and the **GOSPEL ACCORDING TO GRACE**!




At the moment we believe and trust in JESUS CHRIST, **GOD** imputes to our account righteousness - not on the basis of what we have done or what we are going to do, but simply on the basis of our belief in JESUS CHRIST.

If you say that you believe something, but yet you fail to live out that belief, your actions prove that you don't have real **FAITH**.



A lot of people think that merely **SAYING SOMETHING** makes it a belief. But, belief isn't just what we say; belief takes **ACTION**. It is shown by what we do.




Now, this does not mean that our actions are always going to be perfect. We find, at times, that we are **BATTLING OUR flesh** so that we do not do the things we really want to do. Sometimes our activities and actions are opposed to our **FAITH** in **JESUS CHRIST**.

But we can't live in that condition! We may stumble and fall, as everyone does, but we do not just lie there. The **Spirit** won't let us lie there! He prompts us and helps us to stand up again! When we stumble or fall, **GOD** doesn't reject us.



When a parent, trying to teach their son or daughter to walk, sees them stumbling, they don't shout, "You are not my child, falling like that! I disown you!"

No, they pick up their child and say, "You're all right. Try it again. Come here to me. Come on! Come on!" They encourage their child to try again and again.

If you believe in **JESUS CHRIST** you are **GOD'S** child. And if you don't believe, you can come to **JESUS** right now! Do you want to?

He is trying to help you develop a walk with Him. It is comforting to know that when we stumble and fall, He doesn't kick us out. He doesn't disown us. He doesn't say, "You are not my child anymore because you have stumbled!" Instead, He picks us up and dusts us off. He says, "All right now, try again."

WALKING OUR TALK

There are many who claim to have fellowship with **GOD**, who know all the right words to say, but who simply aren't walking with **GOD** in any practical way. It is so important that we learn to "WALK our TALK".

How do we avoid being carried away by the pull of the **WORLD**?





To **"Walk in the Spirit"** means that we allow the **Holy Spirit** to have control over our lives.


It is helpful to remember that **GOD** has designed the human mind to work much as a computer does. A computer can only produce that which has been programmed into it. In the same way, our minds are being programmed daily. If our input comes from the **flesh**, our lives will be characterized by the **flesh**. If we begin to program our minds with the things of the **Spirit**, our lives will begin to reflect the priorities of the **Spirit**.



The simple, yet profound, answer is this...

**"Don't fight the flesh,
strengthen the SPIRIT!"**

Don't fight against the darkness,
turn on the **LIGHT**!





To do this, we must first recognize that we have both a **spiritual** and a **fleshy** side to our nature. If we are to **Walk in the Spirit**, we must feed the **spiritual** side of us. We all know what it means to feed the physical side of our nature. If you miss feeding your body, it reminds you that you are hungry.

Becoming **STRONG** in **Spirit** requires that we must regularly consume the bread of life, the Word of **GOD**.



TAKING IN THE WORD

If we want the **spiritual** side of us to be strong, we must sow to our **Spirit**. We can't sow to the **flesh** and hope that we will produce a **spiritual** crop. In order to **Walk in the Spirit**, we must feed the **Spirit**. This is why we must read the **BIBLE** more and more.

JESUS claimed that His words were **Spirit** and life (**JOHN 6:63**); so a regular time in **GOD'S** word is very important if we are to **Walk in the Spirit**.

Offentimes, we don't know how to read the **BIBLE**. Where should we start? It's such a large book! How should we read it? These are good questions and here are the answers:

A good place to start is in the **GOSPEL OF JOHN**, because it tells us about who **JESUS** is and what He did while living on the earth.



So, start reading the **BIBLE** in the **GOSPEL OF JOHN**. Read what you understand and soon you may come to something that you do not understand. Keep reading. Before long, you will come to something that you do understand. Gradually, what you understand will help you understand what you do not understand! So read your **BIBLE**!




Now, it is important to **RESPOND** to what is said in the **BIBLE**. The **BIBLE** is the Word of **GOD**. It is **GOD** speaking to you.

When someone speaks to you, what do you usually do? You respond back to them.

GOD wants to have fellowship with you, so you need to respond back to what He says.



So, how do you do this? First, find a verse and read it. Then, respond to **GOD** about what He says in this verse, as if He's right there with you; because He is!



(Note: for those who are "born again" / born of the **Spinit**, **GOD** promises that He will never leave you or forsake you - **HEBREWS 13:5**. So He is right there!)

OUR WORKS OR GOD'S SPIRIT

Some people try to come to **GOD** on their own good deeds and actions. Some people think they can go to heaven just by acting good. Even if you **TRY** to have good **fruit** in your life, it will not happen, **BECAUSE** good **fruit** comes from **ABIDING** in the tree!








Notice that the apostle is comparing two things:

The **SPirit**, which is related to **FAITH** and Works, which are related to the **FLESH**.



If you are involved in works, then you are relying on your **flesh**. But if you are walking by **FAITH** in **JESUS CHRIST**, the **Spirit** is producing **fruit** in your life. **Fruit** isn't something you are responsible for; **fruit** is the natural result of your relationship with **JESUS**.



Think about peaches hanging on a peach tree. The peaches aren't out there struggling and working day by day trying to get ripe; all they have to do is hang in there! Ripening is the natural result of relationship. As long as they are hanging on the tree (**ABIDING**), they are going to be sweet peaches.

What does it mean to Abide?

Think about that peach tree again! As long as those peaches are hanging on the tree, they will be just fine. They will turn out sweet! And as long as we hang out with **JESUS**, and stay connected (**ABIDE**) to Him, we will produce good **fruit** in our lives (love: joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, etc.).




BONUS QUESTION: How do we stay connected to **JESUS**?

If we hang out (**ABIDE**) with **JESUS** we will bear good **fruit**. But, just as **fruit** will die if it does not stay on the tree, we will die **spiritually** if we do not **ABIDE** in **JESUS**.




Our big mistake

One of our biggest problems is that we tend to be more interested in what we do than in what we are, while **GOD** is more interested in what we are than in what we do.

He looks for **fruit**;
we try to produce works.

Yes, we are supposed to have **fruit** in our life, but sometimes when we see other people's **fruit**, we think that is what we are to do.






The *fruit* of the Christian life blossoms from us naturally as we **ABIDE** in **JESUS CHRIST** through our **FAITH** in Him.

GOD wants us to be extremely *fruitful* for Him. That *fruit* can come forth only as we **ABIDE** in **JESUS**.



GOD never recognizes or rewards the works of our *flesh*. On the other hand, He jealously desires that the *fruit* of the **Spirit** be increasingly characteristic of our lives.

JESUS placed the emphasis not upon what we DO, but upon what we ARE. What comes forth from our lives is the result of our relationship with Him. We can't have a true, right relationship with the Lord without bringing forth *fruit*. If there is no *fruit* for "by their fruits ye shall know them" then we had better re-examine our relationship with the Lord !

FORGIVEN



GOD did a marvelous work in your life by His **Holy Spirit**. When you were still a sinner, **GOD LOVED** you. And, when by **FAITH** you called out to Him, (have you called out to **JESUS** yet? if not, now would be a good time - do you want to?) He forgave you of every wrong thing you had ever done; as though the bad things you've done never happened! This is what the term "**JUSTIFIED**" means.

Because of your simple belief in **JESUS CHRIST** as your Savior and Lord, **GOD** forgives you of all your past. Because of your belief, **GOD** gives to you the righteousness of **JESUS**. Your relationship with Him begins with believing.

All we have to do is please **GOD**. And what do we have to do to please Him? Just believe in Him and trust in Him. We don't please **GOD** by all of our works and activities. We please **GOD** when we believe in Him and trust in Him. That is the **GOSPEL OF GRACE**.

IT'S MY PLEASURE

FAITH pleases the Lord and **FAITH** produces relationship. The relationship produces the **fruit**. When the **LOVE** of **GOD** fills your heart, all you want to do is talk about Him, His Word, His goodness, His **LOVE**. You do it because you want to do it, because it is your nature to do it, because **GOD** has put it in your heart to do it.




GOD is not interested in your works; He desires to enjoy your **fruit**; He calls you to rely upon His **Spirit**.

BLESSINGS FOR THE TAKING

Once we begin to understand the Word, we see that it isn't our righteousness or ability to reach some high level of holiness that makes us worthy of **GOD'S** blessing. **GOD** blesses us when we simply trust in Him for His blessings.

The longer we live, the more we realize how undeserving and unworthy we are of **GOD'S** touch. He wants to bless us, not because we are good and holy and pure, but because that is His nature.

HE ENJOYS BLESSING HIS CHILDREN!



ALWAYS LOVES US!

IT NEVER VARIES!

His **LOVE** for us is not dependant upon us; it is dependant upon **GOD** and on His nature of **LOVE**.

LOOK UP 1 CORINTHIANS 13:4-8 & read it to see how God loves us.

GOD is **LOVE**.


He **LOVES** you now and He **LOVED** you even when you didn't **LOVE** Him, and were rebelling against Him. He **LOVED** you then. And He **LOVES** you now.

Because **GOD** **LOVES** us, He wants to bless us. His blessings are not dependent upon our goodness, our righteousness, or our **FAITHFULNESS**.

The blessings of **GOD** depend solely upon His desire to bless us. Our part is simply to receive and believe Him for His blessings.



His **LOVE** for us doesn't change from day to day. He doesn't **LOVE** us more today than He **LOVED** us yesterday. **GOD'S** **LOVE** isn't like that. **GOD'S** **LOVE** for us is constant;



WE ARE NO MORE RIGHTEOUS NOW THAN THE FIRST DAY WE BELIEVED.

You can't imagine the **blessing** and power that **GOD** is eager to impart to you if you will just believe and trust Him for it. We are so often like the foolish Galatians. Why would we be so foolish as to return to a legal **RELATIONSHIP** when we can relate to **GOD** in a **LOVE RELATIONSHIP**?

DON'T BE A FOOL and demand what you think you deserve, because you deserve death. All of us do, for all of us sin (**ROMANS 3:23**). **GOD** wants to **bless** you now because He **LOVES** you. **GOD** wants to **bless** your life, and the avenue to that **blessing** is your **FAITH**.




YOU CAN'T MEAN ME!



Some people may believe that **GOD** can't possibly **bless** them because they have failed Him too much or because they are too weak or because they have done something terribly wrong.

The problem is that people are looking for a **blessing** on the basis of their own performance. They are trapped in the kind of thinking that says, "When I become so good and so perfect, then He can bless me." But that is so wrong!



We must get it into our heads that **GOD** wants to fill our lives with the **Holy Spirit**.



When you pray for **GOD** to fill you with the **Holy Spirit**, instantly **Satan** will begin to throw all kinds of **lies** and **accusations** into your mind. He will **distract** you. He will make you feel **guilty** or **unworthy**.



"What are you doing, asking **GOD** for that?" He'll **sneer**. "You should be ashamed of yourself. You have no right!"

Look at what you are. Look at what you have done. How could **GOD** possibly fill you with His **Holy Spirit**?"

What a tragedy! We know we don't deserve the **blessings** of **GOD**, but **GOD** doesn't **bless** us because we deserve it. **GOD** **blesses** us on the basis of His **LOVE** toward us and of His **GRACE** toward us in **CHRIST JESUS**.

That is the basis of the **blessings** - not our goodness, not our righteousness, and not our perfection. If we could just believe this, we'd start being **blessed** like we can't imagine!




The **blessings** are there. **GOD** wants to **bless** you. All you have to do is simply believe Him to **bless** you, though you know you don't deserve it. The **blessings** don't come because of your works, they come because of your belief - because you trust and believe **GOD** will **bless** you.







THE STRUGGLE BEGINS



The *flesh* is a terribly **STRONG** enemy.


Sadly, some *Christians* seem to be fighting a losing **BATTLE** with it!

So... why do some believers never enjoy **GOD'S** victory?

THE ANSWER IS SIMPLE:

they spend all their *effort* and *energy* trying to live a godly life in their own *strength*.

Instead of turning their lives and struggles over to **GOD**, they keep *searching* for some new *technique* – some new *method*, some new *program* to make them righteous. And, none of them ever work!




Our **HELP** doesn't come until we realize the answer is far beyond our own resources. Amazingly, crying out to **GOD** in weakness is the secret to our deliverance.

NOT ANOTHER SELF-IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

We **CANNOT** change our own lives.
We **CANNOT** live a life that pleases **GOD** by our own efforts.

It is only when we admit we are powerless that we find hope. When we finally turn to the grace of God, the Lord intervenes and begins to do a work inside of us that we cannot do for ourselves.





We are in a **FIGHT!** Who can deny there is a **BATTLE** going on inside each of us?

The Master's Battle Plan:


At this point the question arises, so then, what are we to do with the **flesh**? GOD has made a provision for the **flesh**. He calls it **“THE CROSS”**.

The **flesh** must be crucified!



The **flesh** no longer has the appeal it once did and the **BATTLE** inside us is won!





As we overflow with gratitude, we see how **GOD'S** way of TRANSFORMATION is so wonderfully simple and yet much better than our own misguided efforts.



When our victory comes from **GOD'S** work alone, outside of our own efforts, the end result is glory and praise unto **GOD**.



FREE INDEED!



Before we came to **CHRIST**, we were children of wrath; our whole manner of life was spent trying to fulfill the desires of the **flesh**. We were not free; we were slaves to our **flesh**.

What a contrast to the glorious liberty we have been given in **CHRIST JESUS**!

As **Christians**, we receive **GOD'S LOVE** and forgiveness and have been granted freedom from being slaves of our **flesh**. We have been granted the capacity (the **GRACE** and power) to turn from sin to serve and worship **GOD**. We are free in **CHRIST**!

The *Apostle Paul* said that there might be things that as **Christians** we have the freedom to do, but these things could possibly interfere or even hinder our fellowship with the Lord. These things could distract us from total, wholehearted devotion to **GOD**.

So many times, people misunderstand **Christian** liberty, thinking that freedom in **CHRIST** means that they can freely commit all kinds of sin.


Our liberty is never a freedom to sin freely; it is never a license to sin. In fact, we should **AVOID** things that can hinder our fellowship with **GOD**.



HOW SHOULD WE USE OUR FREEDOM IN CHRIST?

We should use our freedom in such a way that it honors **GOD** and helps us to **GROW IN GRACE**.

GOD places a high value on a humble servant. Over and over, the **BIBLE** reminds us that if we want to be really great in **GOD'S** kingdom, we must serve one another in **LOVE**.



GOD'S POWER

JESUS stated, "All power is given unto Me in heaven and in earth" (MATTHEW 28:18).

Can you imagine how much power that must be?! All the **POWER** of the universe was given to Him. The same **POWER** that lit the fires of the stars and holds every atom together belongs to JESUS.

AND WHAT DID HE DO WITH THIS POWER?
SHAKE THE UNIVERSE? SPIN OUT A FEW NEW GALAXIES? NO.



He took off His robe, girded Himself about as a servant, and washed His disciples' feet. After He had washed the last dirty ankles and toes, He asked His men, in effect,

"Do you know what I have done? I have given you an example. For if I, being your Lord, have served you, then so also ought you to serve one another."

What if, right now, you could say, "**ALL POWER IN THE UNIVERSE IS MINE**"? What would you do with such power?

JESUS took a towel and a basin of water and washed the dirty feet of His disciples. All power in the universe was His - and what did He do with it? He washed the disciples' feet.

There are very few of us who want to serve. Instead, we LOVE to give orders and be waited on. "Go get me that!" "Hand that tool to me." "I need you to go."



How we LOVE to give orders, and how we get upset when the orders aren't obeyed! We get hurt, we pout. We enjoy ruling others... But, **GOD'S** greatest blessings are not to be found there. We have been set free, not to boss others around, but to serve one another in LOVE.

Without question, this blessing requires a work of **GOD'S Spirit** within our hearts. Our **flesh** certainly rebels at the idea of serving someone else in LOVE. Often, my immediate reaction to even the simplest request is, "If you want a glass of water, go get it yourself!"



My **flesh** LOVES to be served. But, I have been set free from bondage to my **flesh** and now I can serve others in LOVE. What a joy it is to serve in LOVE. All of the law is summed up in the following three verses:


The **GOLDEN RULE** isn't just avoiding doing wrong; it's actively seeking out practical ways to express LOVE.





JESUS says we fulfill the law first by **LOVING GOD**, then by **LOVING** others and treating them as we would like to be treated.

Our righteousness is based upon simple trust in **JESUS** to wash us and cleanse us of our sins and to make us pure in the eyes of the Father.


The work of our salvation has been done. There is nothing we can do to improve it.




