

"What does it mean to Abide?"



BONUS QUESTION: How do we stay connected to JESUS?



One of our biggest problems is that we tend to be more interested in what we do than in what we are, while GOD is more interested in what we are than in what we do.



What comes forth from our lives is the result of our relationship with Him. We can't have a true, right relationship with the Lord without bringing forth *fruit*. If there is no *fruit* for "by their *fruits* ye shall know them" then we had better reexamine our relationship with the Lord !

FORGIVEN

GOD did a marvelous work in your life by His Holy Spinit. When you were still a sinner, GOD IOVED you. And, when by FAITH you called out to Him, (have you called out to ∂E&US yet? if not, now would be a good time - do you want to?) He forgave you of every wrong thing you had ever done; as though the bad things you've done never happened! This is what the term "JUSTIFIED" means.




GOD is not interested in your works; He desires to enjoy your fruit; He calls you to rely upon His **Spirit**.
