The fegh is a terribly **STRONG** enemy.


Sadly, some **Christians** seem to be fighting a losing **BATTLE** with it!

they spend all their effort and energy trying to live a godly life in their own strength.


Instead of turning their lives and struggles over to GOD, they keep searching for some new technique - some new Method, some new program to make them righteous. And, hone of them ever work!

We CANNOT change our own lives. We CANNOT live a life that pleases GOD by our own efforts.

It is only when we admit we are powerless that we find hope. When we finally turn to the grace of God, the Lord intervenes and begins to do a work inside of us that we cannot do for ourselves.

## The Master's Battle Plan:


At this point the question arises, so then, what are we to do with the  $f(\mathfrak{h})$ ? **GOD** has made a provision for the f h. He calls it




We cannot redeem the fesh. We cannot dress it up. The fesh must be crucified!

When we allow the **Spirit** of **GOD** to take over and work in our lives, we can triumph over our fallen nature - the flesh

Whenever we encounter an area of the flesh that still controls us, we need to honestly acknowledge the **BATTLE** of the flesh; then by FAITH, we need to bring that specific area of weakness to the cross and reckon (consider) it crucified.

When also gives us a new set of desires. We begin to long for intimate fellowship with GOD, a deeper knowledge and understanding of His Word, and closer communion with others who are alive in CHRIST JESUS. Our lives begin to change!


The f h no longer has the appéal it once did and the **BATTLE** inside us is won!




