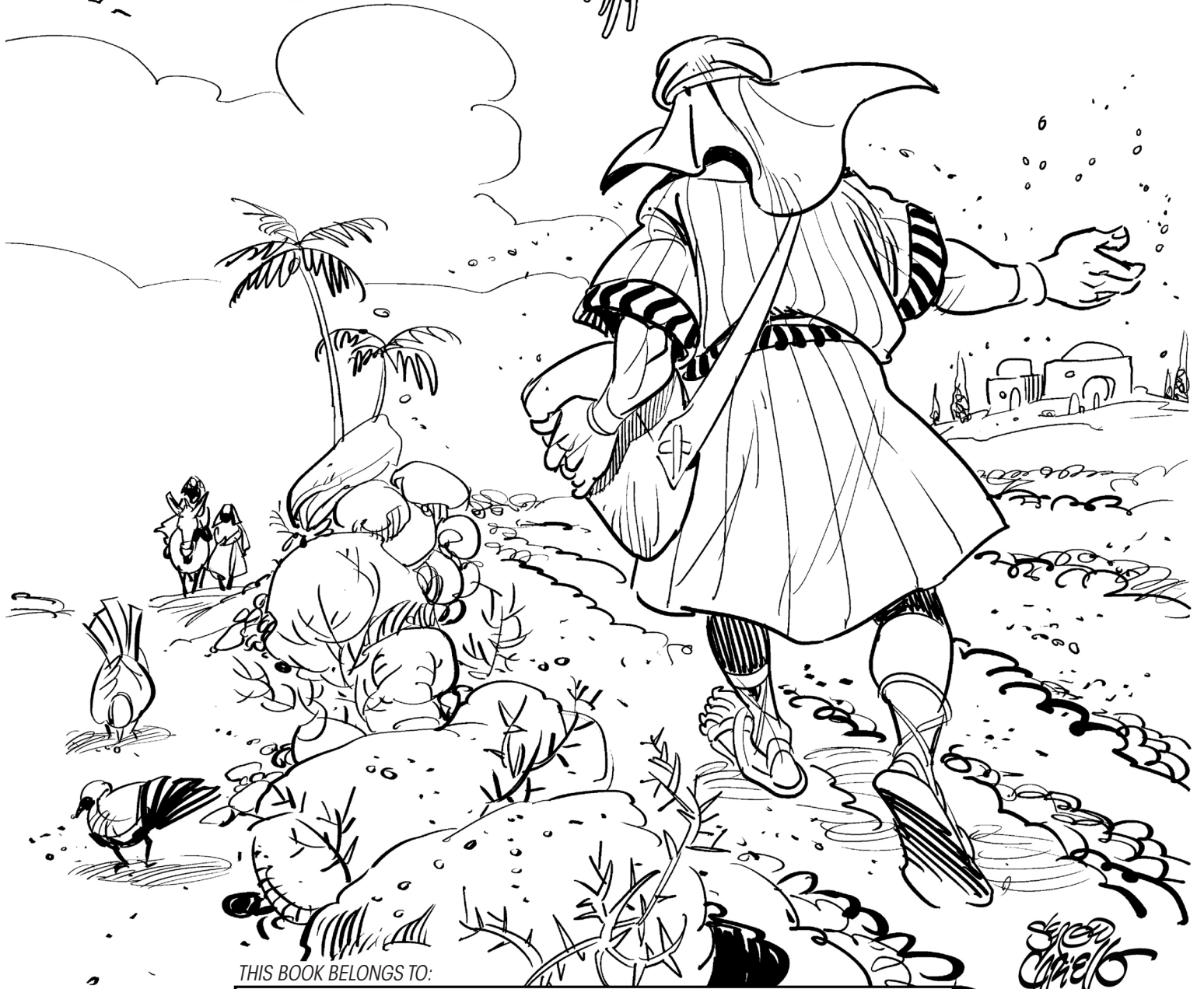

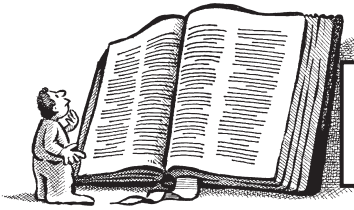

LET'S START BY READING GALATIANS 6:8 TOGETHER

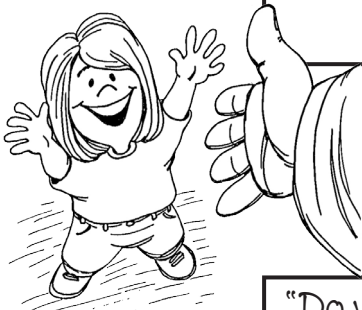
"For he who sows to his flesh will of the flesh reap corruption, but he who sows to the Spirit will of the Spirit reap everlasting life."

This verse tells us of two ways we present ourselves. What are the two ways? Talk about what those two ways mean.

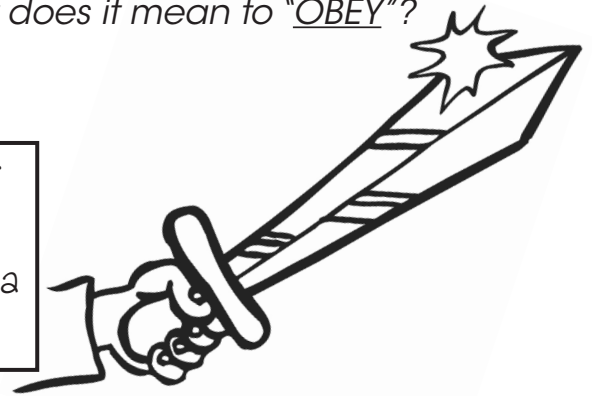

The  tells us in **HEBREWS 4:12**

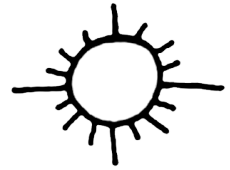

It is the Word of **GOD** that feeds the **SPiRiT**. If we feed our mind the Word of **GOD**, reading the Bible and listening to the Word of **GOD** being taught, we are **SOWING to the SPiRiT**.

As we feed our **SPiRiT**, we will reap of the **SPiRiT**. So, it is very important what we **SOW** into our lives.

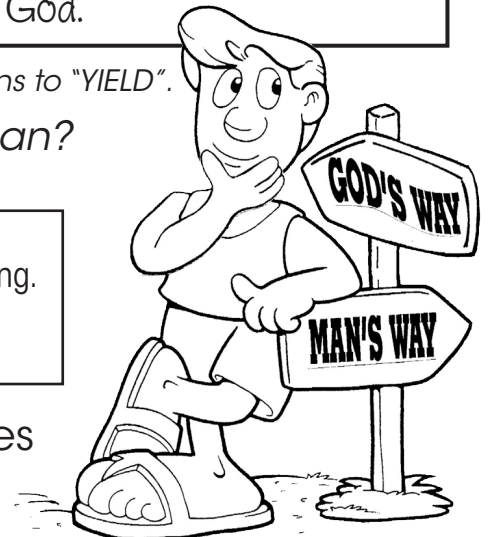


Remember that the word "PRESENT" in this verse means to "YIELD".

Considering everything from this study, what does **ROMANS 12:1-2** mean for each of our lives?



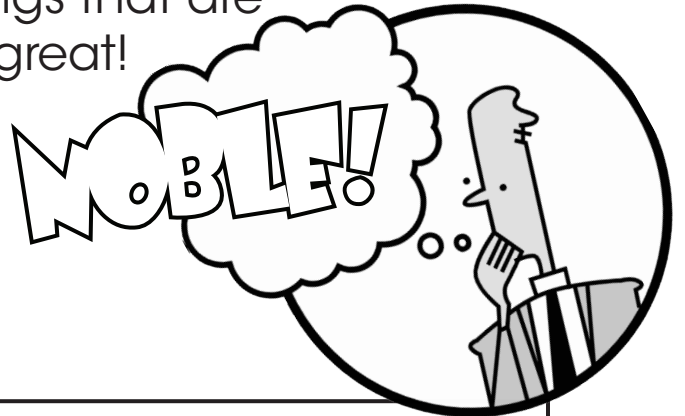

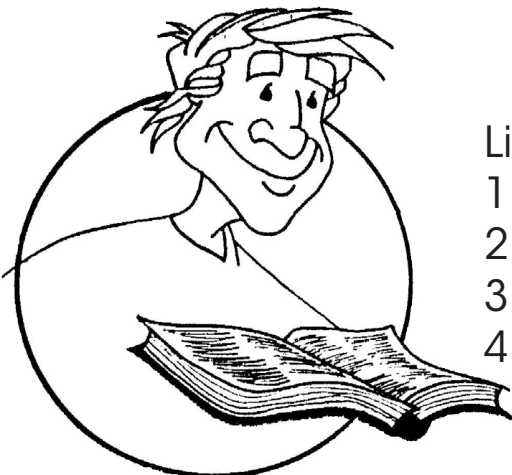
To **SEEK** means...

So, now that we know what it means to "**SEEK**", how should we live?

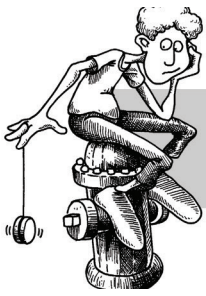
