

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
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GENESIS 7:6 - 9:17



UNDERSTANDING THE STORY:

Noah built the ark (big boat) just as God told him to. Then God told him to come into the ark with his family.

- What else went into the ark with Noah and his family? Can you name some animals that went into the ark?
- After they were safe inside the ark, what began to happen? For how many days and nights did it rain?

God sent rain onto the earth and also opened the fountains of the great deep, so that there was a lot of water to flood the whole earth.

- What happened to the ark as the rain fell and the waters became deeper and deeper on the earth?
- Did the water also cover the high hills and mountains?
- What happened to everything that was on the dry land and was not in the ark? Did God protect those who were in the ark, who had obeyed Him?

After the whole earth was flooded, God made the rain stop and He sent a wind to blow on the earth.

- Would the wind help dry the waters? As the water went down more and more, what happened to the ark? (Genesis 8:4) What could be seen above the waters? (Genesis 8:5)
- Noah opened the window and sent out a bird, called a raven. After that, what kind of bird did Noah send out? Did the dove return to the ark?
- When the dove went out again, seven days later, what did it bring back in its mouth?
- Did the dove come back to the ark the third time? What did that mean?

When the earth was dry, God told Noah to leave the ark with his wife, his sons and his sons' wives, and all of the animals.

- Noah built an altar to worship God. Do you think that Noah was thankful to God?
- What promise did God make? (Genesis 8:21, 9:11) What sign did God put in the sky to remind people of His promise?

SIMPLE TRUTHS:

Noah was a person who loved and obeyed God even when there was lots of badness around him.

• Can we be like Noah? Will it be a blessing to God when we love and obey Him? Will it also be a blessing to us when we love and obey God?

God is sad when people live wickedly. Today, lots of people are still sinning and doing wrong.

- What did Jesus do for us to save us from the power of sin? When Jesus died on the cross was He being punished for something He did, or for the sin that we have done?
- If we trust in Jesus and ask Him to forgive us, will He forgive us and make us part of His family? Do you want to pray and do that now?

God promised to never again flood the whole earth with water.

- When we see a beautiful rainbow in the sky, what should we remember? Has God kept that promise?
- Will God always keep His promises to us?

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


WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

- Tape OR Glue


BEFORE CLASS INSTRUCTIONS:
