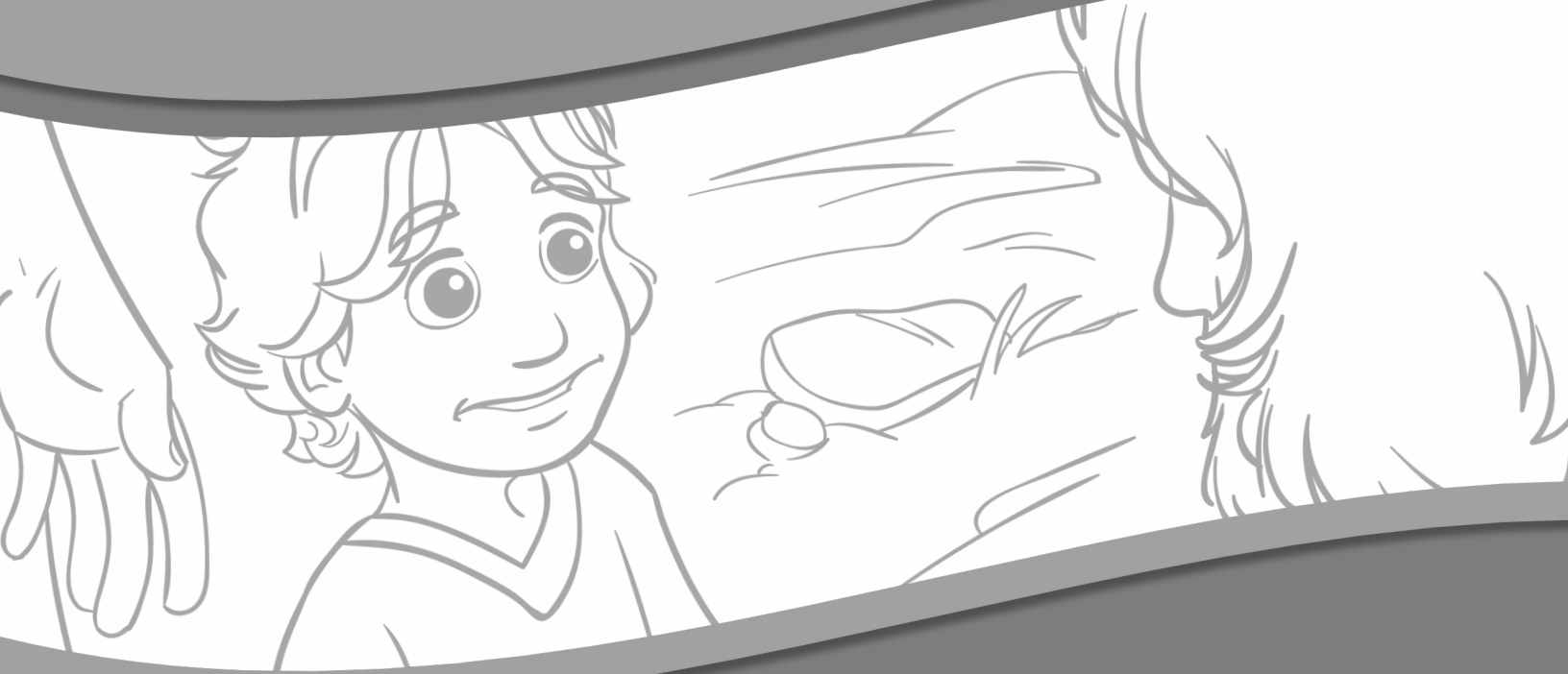

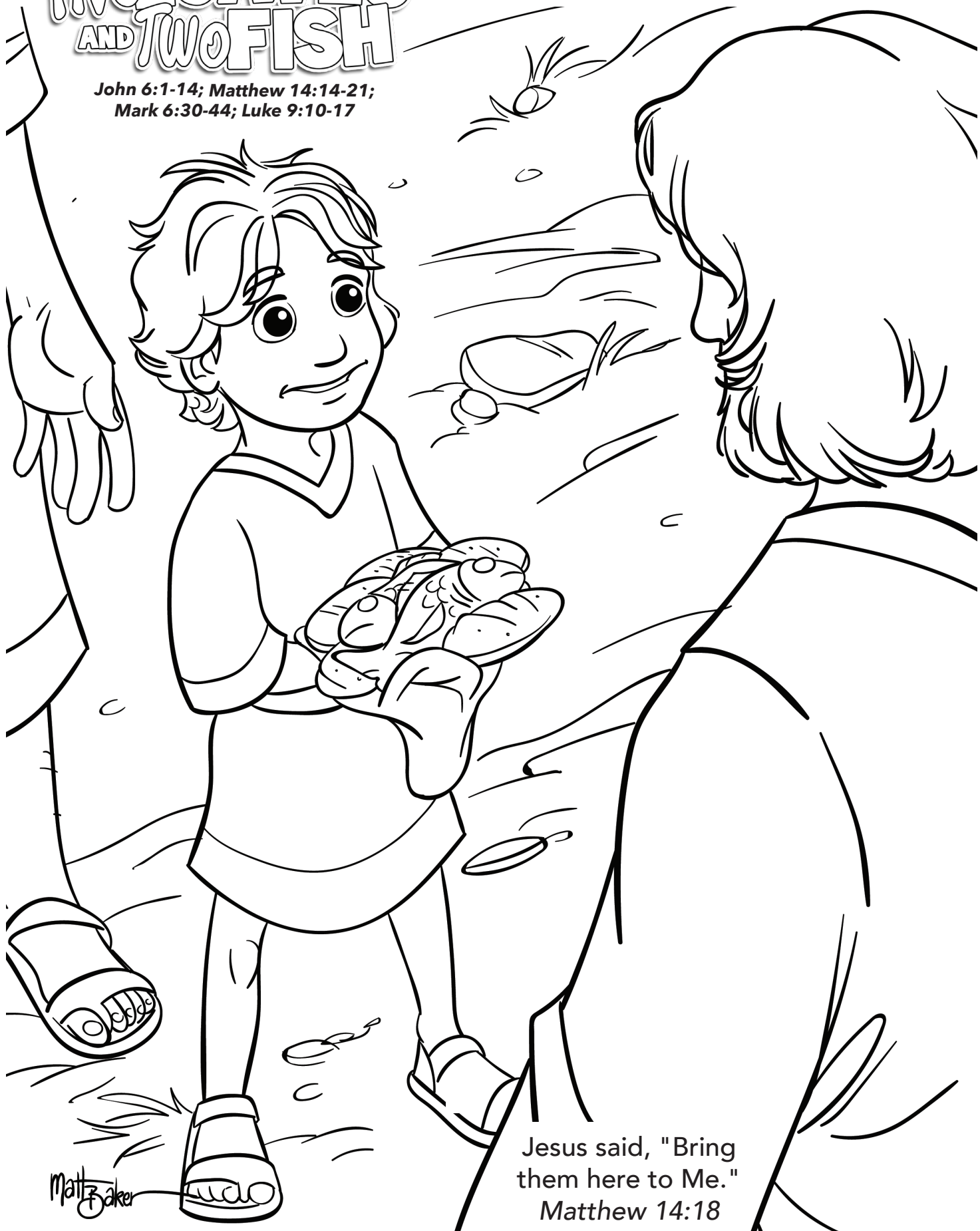

## UNDERSTANDING THE STORY:

**Jesus had spent the day helping people. He had been teaching them about God and healing those who were sick.**

- *What does this teach us about Jesus? Instead of being with the people, what else could Jesus have been doing? What was important to Jesus? When Jesus saw the large crowd of people, what did He have in his heart? (Mark 6:34 - Compassion; Jesus felt sorry and sad for the people and wanted to help them.)*

**Jesus, His disciples, and a crowd of people were far away from any place that had food. It was getting late in the day and the people needed to eat.**

- *Jesus said that the disciples should give the people something to eat. Did the disciples have enough food to feed such a big crowd of people?*
- *There was somebody there with food. Who was it? (John 6:9) How much food did the boy have? Was that enough food to feed over 5,000 people?*
- *What did Jesus do after He had taken the five loaves and two fish? What did Jesus tell the disciples to do with the food?*

**There was not enough food to feed the people. But, then, there was enough!**

- *What happened?*
- *Was there only enough food for the people to eat a little? How many baskets did the disciples fill with the food that was left over?*

## SIMPLE TRUTHS:

**Jesus was not thinking about Himself being tired or wanting to be alone. He was thinking about the people and how He could help them.**

- *Most of the time we think about ourselves. Do you think that God wants us to think more about how we can bless and help other people? Let's ask Jesus now to help us love other people more.*

**Jesus did a lot with just a little. God can do a lot with us if we give our lives to Him.**

- *How do you think the boy felt when he realized what Jesus had done with his small amount of food?*
- *Is there anything that we can give to Jesus, even if it seems small? What do we have that we can give to Jesus? (A few ideas are: Talking to Jesus and listening to the Bible, giving a hug to someone who is sad, saying something kind to someone, giving away our money... God can even use \$1.00 if He wants to.)*
- *Let's ask Jesus now what He wants us to give to Him.*
- *What is the very best thing that we can give to Jesus? (Our lives.) Does anyone want to pray and do that now? (If a child/children want to do this, consider leading them in prayer.)*

## AND REMEMBER...

*When we bring what we have to  
Jesus, He can do amazing things.  
He can do miracles!*

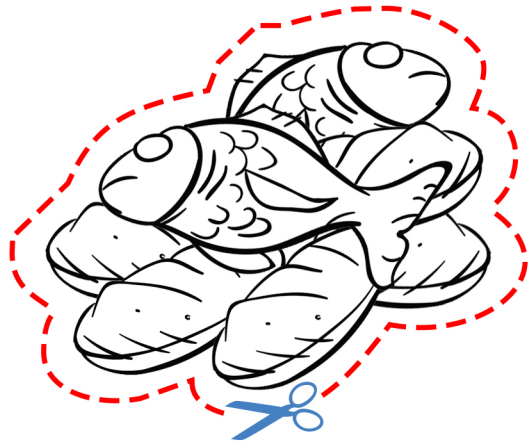
# FIVE LOAVES AND TWO FISH **THE** CRAFT

- Tape **OR** Glue

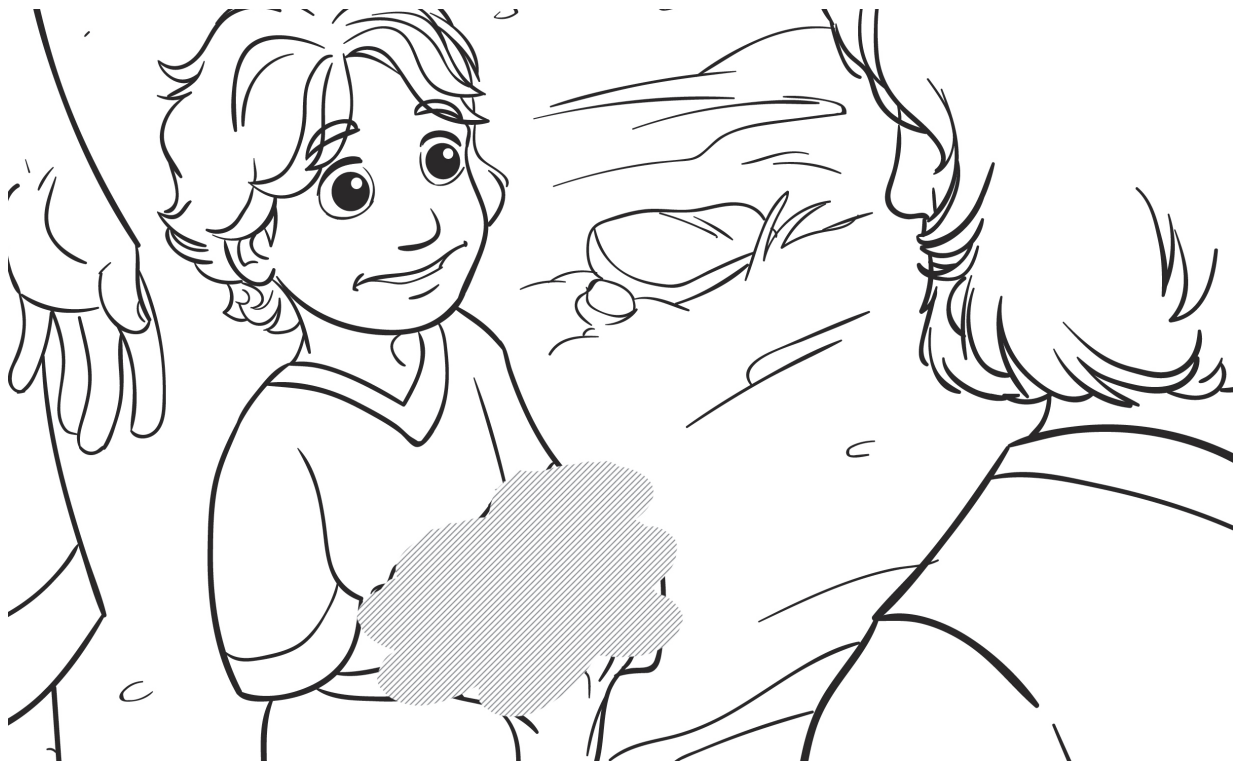
## BEFORE CLASS INSTRUCTIONS:
